We have now entered into the Lenten Season in earnest. I pray that you have entered the spiritual desert with Our Lord and will find yourself ever closer to Him by the time we come to the holy season of Easter. Please remember that we are offering confessions every Monday and Wednesday at 7:00 PM and on Saturdays following the 9:00 AM Mass and at 3:30 PM. Ridding oneself of sin is a serious part of Lent. Also, every Friday, we are having a talk on one of the Sorrows of Saint Joseph, followed by the Stations of the Cross. We have a beautiful opportunity for a spiritual experience on Sunday, March 7th. The Sisters of Life will be offering two talks which will be within an afternoon of prayer and reflection before the Most Blessed Sacrament, culminating with the Holy Mass at 6:00 PM. The following is the schedule:

2:00 PM – Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with an Opening Prayer Service
2:20 PM – Silent Adoration
2:45 PM – Talk #1 by a Sister of Life ending with a music meditation
3:45 PM – Holy Rosary for Life
4:15 PM – Silent Adoration
4:30 PM – Talk #2 by a Sister of Life ending with a music meditation
5:30 PM – Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament
6:00 PM – Holy Mass celebrating the Gift of Life

We are excited to spend this special afternoon with Our Lord and welcoming the Sisters of Life to our parish. You will see how special these sisters are and the joy and hope they bring. With the strokes of a pen we are seeing very discouraging and horrific decisions made against life. We must never lose hope and this afternoon is about thanking the Lord for the gift of life and to pray for the sustaining of life as we live in this culture of death. The Sisters of Life say on their website: “We believe every person is valuable and sacred. We believe that every person is good, loved, unique and unrepeatable. We believe that every person’s life has deep meaning, purpose and worth. In fact, we give our lives for that truth.” Our Lady of Hope is our patroness and thus, we are called to bear witness to hope. 

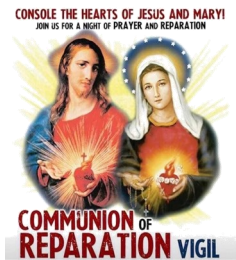

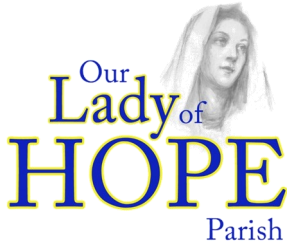
