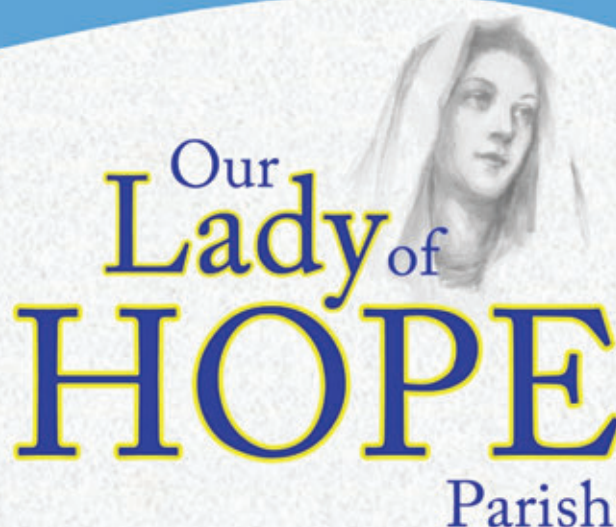

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

Pope Francis announced the Year of Joseph celebrating the 150th anniversary of the naming of Saint Joseph as patron of the Universal Church. This year began this past December 8th and will continue through December 8, 2021. The Pope promulgated this celebration with a document called *Patris Corde* which means “a Father’s heart.” The Pope says in his document, “Joseph found happiness not mere self-sacrifice, but in self-gift.” As every month is dedicated to a particular devotion, it is a joy to celebrate Saint Joseph to whom the month of March is given. St. Alphonsus Liguori gave us the following litany:

Go, then to Joseph, and do all that he shall say to you;
Go to Joseph, and obey him as Jesus and Mary obeyed him;
Go to Joseph, and speak to him as they spoke to him;
Go to Joseph, and consult him as they consulted him;
Go to Joseph, and honor him as they honored him;
Go to Joseph, and be grateful to him as they were grateful to him;
Go to Joseph, and love him, as they love him still.

There are no words from his lips in Sacred Scripture, yet his actions preached over and over. As we begin this month of Joseph and enter into our Lent, silence is something that is necessary to have a deep prayer life. Mother Teresa would say, “The fruit of silence is prayer.” There is certainly a lot of noise in our lives that can distract us from finding the Presence of God. Perhaps we can appreciate silence more, praying in the church and chapel *in silence*. We talk, talk and talk...too often, we do not listen. Regretfully, our churches are life gymnasiums with loud conversations that so disturbs those who long to have a little peace before the Lord. We are so blessed to have grounds outside and a large vestibule. I exhort all of us to be in silent awe within the church and to speak in a low whisper should we find the need to converse. We may be surprised how much we advance in the spiritual life if we quiet our environment as much as possible. A bank of candles at the great shrine to Saint Joseph in Montreal reminds us, “Go to Joseph.” If we want to understand his secret, we will find it in holy silence. Going to Joseph is a blessed path to Our Lady and above all, to the Lord Jesus. Saint Joseph, pray for us!


