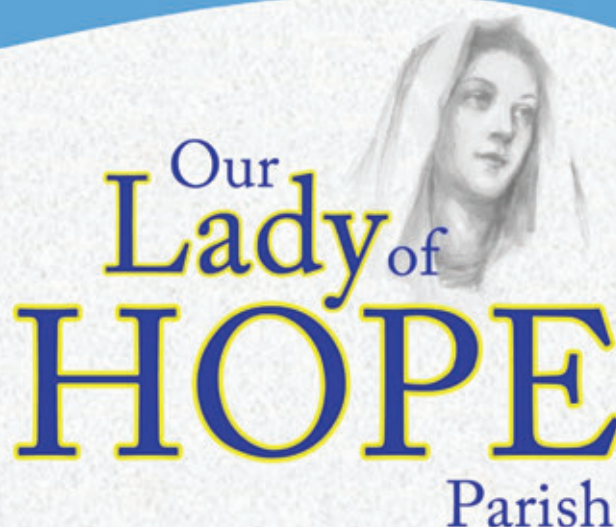

## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*

Dear Friends in Christ,

This past weekend, we were blessed to have the Sisters of Life with us. What a grace! If you missed spending time with us on Sunday afternoon, regretfully, you missed a special time with the Lord. A sister spoke at every Mass with the exception of the 7:30 Mass to introduce the community. One of the sisters speaks Spanish and thus, we even had sisters visit the Saint Jude Latino community. This Sunday is Laetare Sunday which means joy. It is a tradition to wear rose colored vestments when offering Holy Mass. The first sister who gave a main talk was Sister Gaudia. Her very name means joy and she spoke eloquently of the joy that we can find in the spiritual life. The second talk, offered by Sister Maeve spoke of the Cross. This talk was very open and pure, giving great meaning to the love of Jesus offered to the world from His Cross. We also hosted the sisters in our rectory for a few meals while they visited us and I can only say that our house was alive with laughter, prayerful discussions about the work everyone does for Jesus and how we all got to the point of offering our lives to the Lord Jesus. We are often so blessed to have seminarians with us on the altar and in our rectory. We are a parish where our future priests love to spend time at Our Lady of Hope. The Sisters of Life being with us reminded of the gift that are women religious; those who are living an authentic religious life, can impact on people in a powerful way. 
