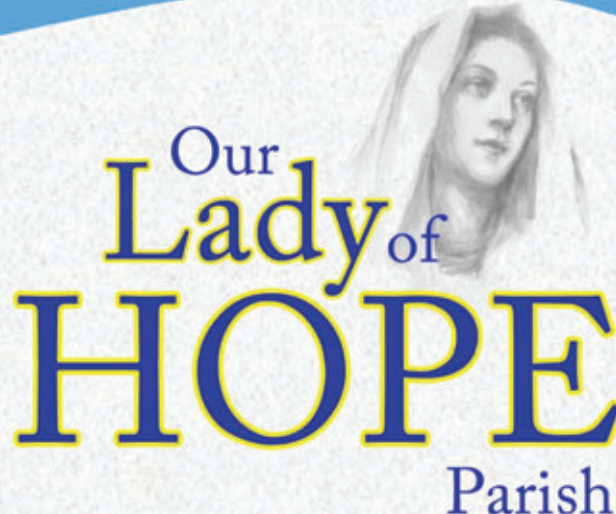

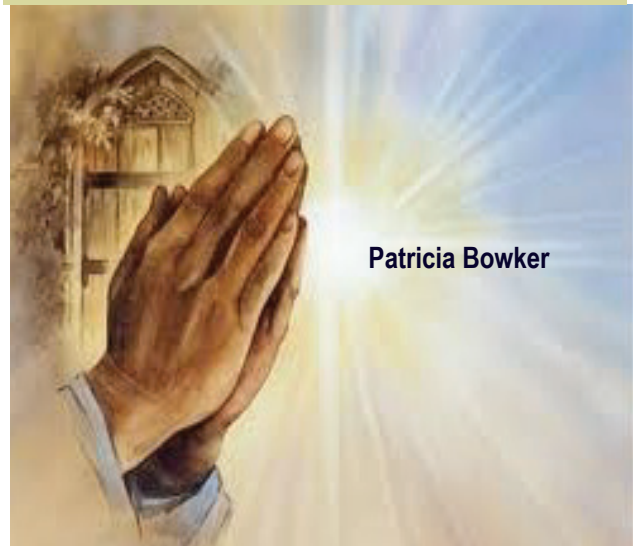

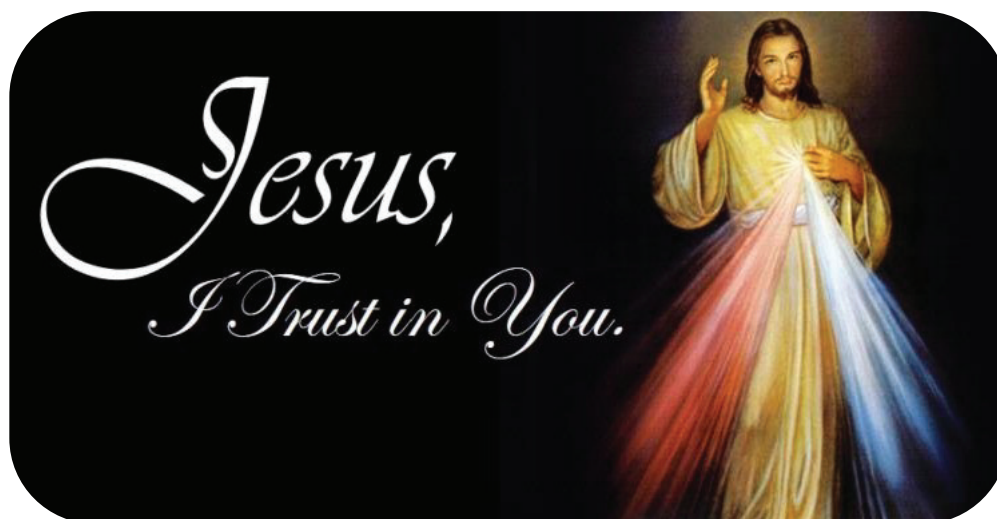


## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*

Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy Easter and blessed Feast of Divine Mercy! I am grateful to all who offered their donations for Easter and for our Easter flowers. Your gifts of food, cakes and cards have meant so much to us. Thank you so much for your prayers for your priests. You sustain us with your love and prayers to our Heavenly Father for us. We really have parishioners who love Our Lady of Hope parish. It has been so edifying to see people visiting the church every day to pray and to see people pray at our grotto to Our Lady. We are so excited that on May 2<sup>nd</sup> Bishop Sullivan will come to our parish to offer the 12:00 Noon Mass and to dedicate the grotto. The Holy Spirit is so active in our parish and I see this with the numbers that were at Mass for the Holy Triduum. This was one of the happiest Triduums of my life! We celebrate the Divine Mercy Sunday this year with our friends at Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish. Please see the website for information. Saint John Paul II died on the morning of the Feast of the Divine Mercy in 2005. He was to deliver a message on Divine Mercy Sunday at the Angelus. The following is part of that text: "As a gift to humanity, which sometimes seems bewildered and overwhelmed by the power of evil, selfishness and fear, the Risen Lord offers his love that pardons, reconciles and reopens hearts to love. It is a love that converts hearts and gives peace. How much the world needs to understand and accept Divine Mercy!" A plenary indulgence may be obtained on this special day. A plenary indulgence means that by the merits of Jesus Christ, the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the saints, the full remission of the temporal punishment due to sin is sacramentally forgiven. Normally, when we go to confession our sins are forgiven, but the punishment due to sin must be made up for through our penances. An indulgence is special in that it is a special grace from God that takes the place of what we would do for our penance. One may go to confession within eight days of the feast day to be part of the gift of Divine Mercy. Jezu, ufam Tobie! (Jesus, I trust in Thee!).



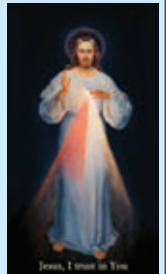
