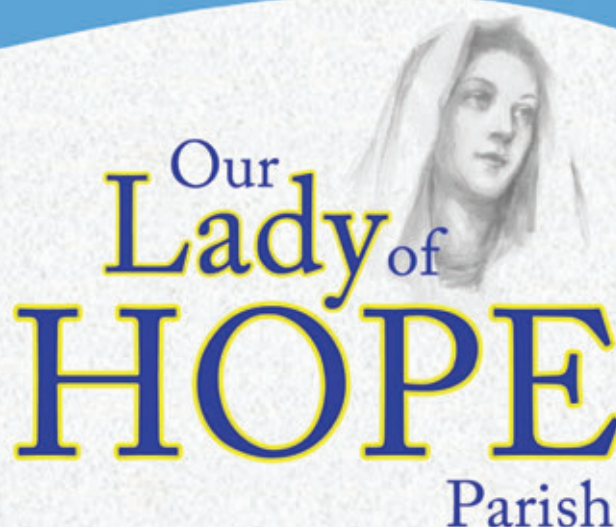

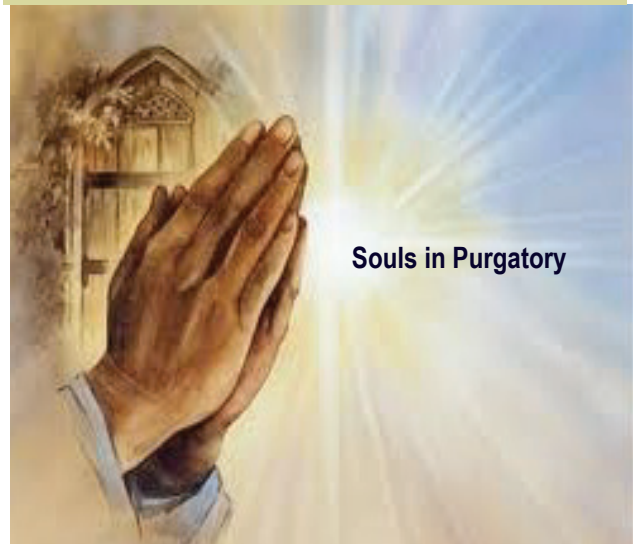

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

This is a beautiful time of the year as the trees bloom everywhere one looks. I am reminded of our faith which brings such beauty to a world that is confused and which does not realize the need for God. Throughout the world we continue to see lockdowns; in particular closed churches. Recently, there were pictures of people being arrested for attending Holy Mass in London. I am so grateful that we were allowed to have our churches opened for the Sacred Triduum and Easter Masses. I would hate to be arrested with the faithful of our parish who love the Mass so much and who would not have accepted another Easter without the Holy Mass. Hopefully, people are giving thanks to the Lord that we were able to come to the House of God to celebrate the Lord's conquering of sin and death. We priests heard hundreds of confessions over the Lenten Season right up to Holy Saturday morning. This is a great sign of a blossoming of the faith in our midst. Like the flowers on the fruit trees, the Holy Spirit is gently blowing the blossoms of our faith for all to see. I can only say that I see Our Lady of Hope as a very special place of prayer and refuge. People love to come to our church, to pray on our grounds at the grotto, at the statues of the Holy Family under the gazebo, at the statue of Saint Francis of Assisi and at the statue of St. Padre Pio. 

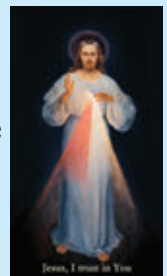
"Divine Mercy Chaplet in Song" was the focus for last Sunday night's Zoom call . . .
