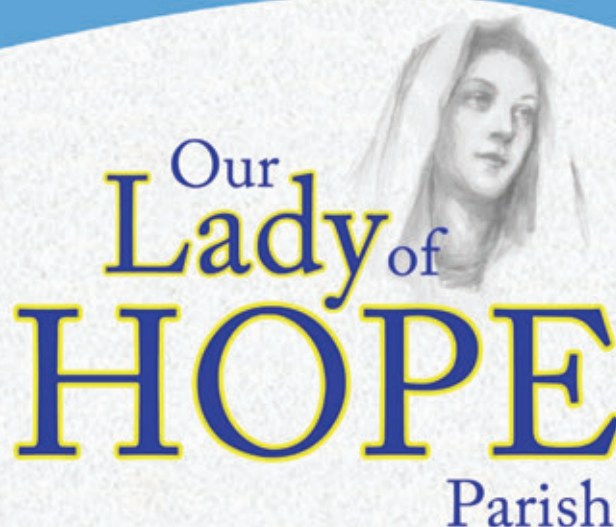

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

We are almost at our celebration and blessing of our Blessed Mother grotto! The event will take place on Sunday, May 2, 2021 after the 12:00 Noon Mass. Bishop Sullivan will offer Holy Mass at 12:00 PM and then we will process to the grotto for the blessing. So many of our faithful have been so generous...so generous. I am so proud and edified by the great love our parish has for Our Most Holy Mother Mary. No parish has what we have! The graces that are being bestowed upon us are so wonderful. John Colaiani has worked so hard to overseeing this project and we are all indebted to him and those who have worked so closely with him. This would never have happened if John did not listen to the Holy Spirit Whom I am convinced wanted this shrine. It is always a joy for me to look out and see people praying the Stations of the Cross or lighting a candle at the shrine or sitting in their car and praying. Our church is open daily until 7:00 PM for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament and so, we are truly land that is dedicated to the glory of God and which is truly wrapped in the mantel of the Blessed Mother. So often, people see devotion to Our Lady as an extra rather than a necessity. Saint Louis de Montfort wrote in *True Devotion to Mary: With Preparation for Total Consecration*, "If, then, we establish solid devotion to our Blessed Lady, it is only to establish more perfectly devotion to Jesus Christ, and to provide an easy and secure means for finding Jesus Christ. If devotion to Our Lady removed us from Jesus Christ, we should have to reject it as an illusion of the devil; but so far from this being the case, devotion to Our Lady is, on the contrary, necessary for us—as I have already shown, and will show still further hereafter—as a means of finding Jesus Christ perfectly, of loving Him tenderly, of serving Him faithfully." You are very welcome to attend Mass at 12:00 with Bishop Sullivan and/or to come to the dedication. Saint John Paul II said in *Redemptoris Mater* (Mother of the Redeemer), "Another essential element of Mary's maternal task is found in her words to the servants: 'Do whatever he tells you.' The Mother of Christ presents herself as the spokeswoman of her Son's will, pointing out those things which must be done so that the salvific power of the Messiah may be manifested. At Cana, thanks to the intercession of Mary and the obedience of the servants, Jesus begins 'his hour.'" Our Lady of Hope help us to love your Son more and more each day!



"Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said to them, "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."

These final earthly words of Jesus set forth the mission of the Apostles and of us all. We are called to evangelize the world.

Shared reflections . . .

Do you understand the purpose of Christ's life?

Fr. March: To love - - to demonstrate it, to allow us to experience it, to empower us to give it.

Do you understand the mysteries of His human life, suffering, death, and Resurrection and how these truths of our faith change you at your very core?

Christian: On suffering - - Shared from his baseball team chaplain's homily . . . Wisdom comes through suffering. Often times the wisest people have suffered the most. They are able to use that suffering to show love and empathy like Jesus did (i.e. a young couple, whose son took his own life at 16, shows love and empathy through their pain). So suffering is a necessary, yet inadequate, means to love.

Do you understand your duty to be a witness to these mysteries of faith to others?
