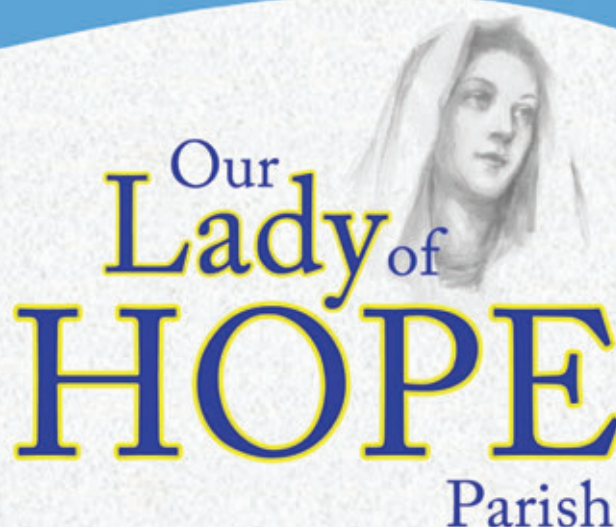

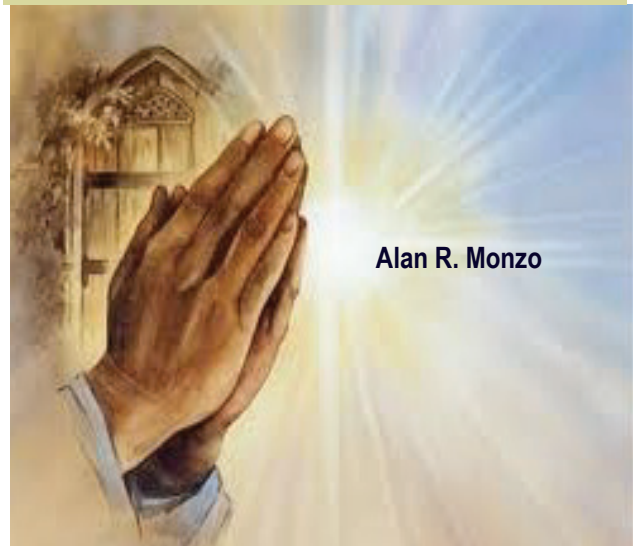

## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*

Dear Friends in Christ,

We begin the beautiful month dedicated to the Holy Mother of God! We begin now the month of May, a beautiful month for so many reasons. For me, it contains so much that I love: it is the month of the Queen of the May, the Blessed Virgin Mary; it starts off with the feast of Saint Joseph, the patron saint of workers; it is the month that I was first ordained to the diaconate and then to the Holy Priesthood; it is the month of First Communion and May Crownings; and is the month where flowers and trees blossom in abundance (although we allergy sufferers might see that one as a mixed bag!). We are so blessed this weekend to have our bishop with us to dedicate our grotto. While there is still more to do, it is ready for the blessing. We want to bring a smile to the Holy Queen and thus, please her Son. So often, people see devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary as an “extra.” It is something sweet and nice to have. In reality, she is so much more and it is one of the reasons it would be unthinkable for me not to be Catholic. Without her loving presence, so much would be missing from one’s spiritual life. Saint Maximilian Kolbe once said, “Never be afraid of loving the Blessed Virgin too much. You can never love her more than Jesus did.” At this point in my life, I cannot remember not loving the Holy Mother of God. What joy she brings when we see a statue, an icon or painting of the Blessed Lady. The Holy Rosary is a chain of powerful love that calls us to meditate over and over the mysteries that make up our holy faith. Saint Mother Teresa always had a Rosary in her hand and Saint John Paul II declared the Rosary as his favorite prayer. His secretary once said that if John Paul II was to stay on schedule at an event, do not let him pass a statue of Our Lady for he will stop and pray which would throw off the whole schedule. The prayer might go on and on and no one could budge him when immersed in prayer! Pope Francis has a love for the Mother of God. He spoke to the people of Poland about Our Lady of Jasna Gora: “She is a true mother, with a marked face, a mother who suffers because she truly carries in her heart the problems in our lives...She is a close mother, who never loses us from her sight; she is a tender mother, who holds our hand on the path of daily life.” If you want to really know the Lord Jesus, go to Our Mother who, only second to Our Heavenly Father, knows Her Son. Yes, let us increase love for the glorious patroness of our parish, Our Lady of Hope.
