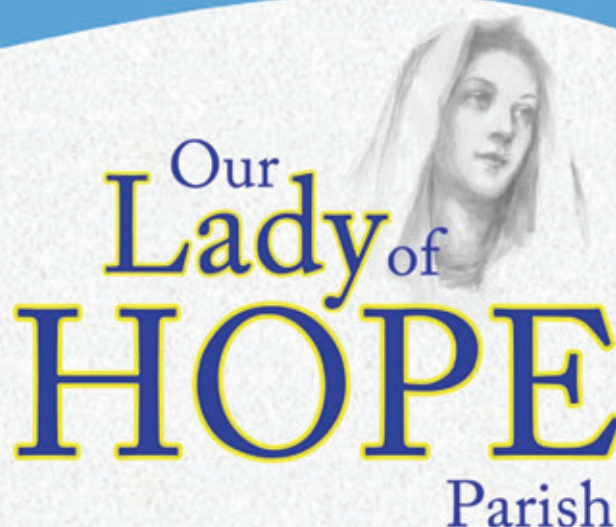

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

Our grotto to the Blessed Virgin Mary has officially been dedicated. Please see in this bulletin the story of the grotto. The Lord blessed us with perfect weather. I was so proud of our parish and was so happy that in these times, our bishop could be with us and see just how special Our Lady of Hope parish truly is. I am so grateful to the band, our choir and John, Casey and Ted. My brother Knights were out in force on every level including color guard and labor. As usual the Knights were on the forefront of this blessed event. Our Altar and Rosary was present and celebrated the Holy Mother of God again since they had crowned Our Lady of Lourdes in our church at the 4:30 PM Mass. I want to thank our May Queen, Christella Dizon, who carried Our Lady's crown of gold roses on a golden, silk pillow to the shrine and crowned the Holiest of Queens. Christella is Deacon Andy's goddaughter. We still have work to do at the grotto, so your continued donations are appreciated. I share with you two further dreams for the enhancement of our parish. I hope to one day have bells ring from our church, calling us to pray and to also build an overhang sheltering the road in front of our church so that people can be let off during inclement weather. As in all things, if the Lord wills it and if the faithful would like to see these things happen. Once again, I want to thank John Colaiani for his vision and oversight of the creation of the grotto. It would never have happened without him and above all, I must express my gratitude to everyone who has given any amount to the cause of the grotto. Some of you gave donated unbelievable amounts to Our Lady's shrine. To all, every dollar, week after week makes a difference. May our battle cry against evil be "To Jesus through Mary!"

With the improvement of our situation concerning the "pandemic" we see some loosening of the restrictions in our church per the Office of the Vicar General. You will notice that the tape has been removed from the pews. Please continue to be prudent in sitting near anyone, allowing space between you and anyone outside your family. We need no longer wipe the pews down after the Sunday Mass, but we will continue to wipe the door handles of the church. The sign of peace will be reinstated, but one should not shake hands with anyone outside their family members. A nod to your neighbor will do. You can smile, but no one will see it through your mask! The collection will once again be taken up by the ushers at the Masses rather than simply having a basket in the vestibule. We will not reintroduce the Precious Blood for the foreseeable future. We will have some Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion assist at Holy Mass soon enough. They will be utilized in the absence of the priests and deacons who will continue to distribute Holy Communion at every Mass. As ordinary ministers of Holy Communion, it is an abuse for the priest or deacon to refrain from distributing Our Lord in order to have an Extraordinary Minister distribute Holy Communion. The most important function of the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion is to bring Holy Communion to the sick and to shut-ins.

Finally, pray for Christopher Myers, Logan Nilsen, Cesar Pirateque Serrano and Steven Robbins as they will be ordained to the Transitional Diaconate at the hands of Bishop Sullivan this Saturday. These men will be ordained for service to the Church on the feast day of Saint Isadore (or San Isidro) the Farmer. Saint Isadore died on May 15, 1130 and was known for his love for the poor and for animals. He was canonized at the same ceremony as some spiritual giants in the Church: Saint Ignatius of Loyola, Saint Francis Xavier, Saint Teresa of Avila and Philip Neri. Wow! Now, that is a powerhouse group of graced sons and a daughter of the Church! There is an interesting fact concerning the relics of Saint Isadore. Only the King of Spain can order the opening of the reliquary and it can only be opened by the Archbishop of Madrid for the veneration of the relics of Saint Isadore and his wife, Santa Maria de la Cabeza. May our soon to be new deacons be blessed as they spend this year preparing for ordination to the Holy Priesthood.

Saying Yes to Our Blessed Mother

The story begins in South Philadelphia, at an assisted living facility located at 5th and Moore Street. The "Home", as it was affectionately called, was founded by an Augustinian, Brother Jude Sanelli O.S.A. in 1973. The Home provided care and peace for hundreds of people in need over the years of operation.

The Home was a spiritual place with two chapels and a small outside grotto. The grotto was home to a Blessed Mother statue where many residents and visitors were able to find peace to pray and meditate.

Unfortunately, with the death of Brother Jude in 2001, the Home had to be sold shortly thereafter. Many of the statues, tabernacles, and religious items needed a new home. The Our Lady of Hope Business Manager, John Colaianni, Jr., the nephew of the late Brother Jude, knew the perfect resting spot for these items - at Our Lady of Hope Parish. All religious items were placed throughout the parish; however, the grotto statue of Our Lady was placed in storage, awaiting the perfect destination.

By the grace of God and Our Blessed Mother, the perfect destination for our Blessed Mother's statue was found in the appointment of Father Joseph Szolack as the new pastor in 2016. His strong devotion to the Blessed Mother provided the opportunity to create a new home for the statue.

The parish's retention pond was decided as the new home for the Blessed Mother statue. The retention pond provides the drainage for all the water from our parish parking lots. Over the years, many organizations attempted to maintain and beautify the retention area. However, there was little to no sustained success.

Through generous donations of our parishioners and the blessing of our Diocese, Our Lady of Hope Parish was able to move forward in creating a Grotto. This labor of love, prayers, and contributions of our Parishioners commenced in earnest in early 2017. The statue of Our Lady in storage at the parish, became the center piece for our Grotto.

A vision, the helping hands of the many contractors, an architect, and our faithful parishioners have made our Grotto a reality.

All who have said "YES to Our Blessed Mother" have made this dedication day May 2, 2021 a reality.
