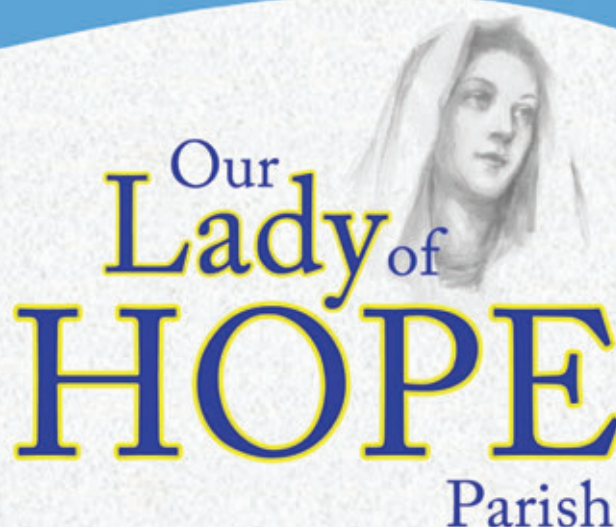

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear friends in Christ,

We continue to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary who is the fairest of all flowers and who is called the Queen of the May. As you know, flowers are so important to us as they adorn the sanctuary, giving glory to God. I often see the notice in an obituary, "In lieu of flowers, please offer such and such..." As for me, I want above all lots of Masses offered for my poor soul and also, I want flowers everywhere! I was reading an article on flowers and what they symbolize. Here are a few examples: calla lilies represent purity, honesty and innocence; a red carnation symbolizes love, pride and admiration for someone; one of my favorites, chrysanthemums, symbolize fidelity, optimism, joy and long life; daffodils symbolize new birth and a new beginning; daisies symbolize innocence; gardenias symbolize love and sophistication; another favorite of mine are the gladiolas which symbolize generosity, sincerity, a strength of character, faithfulness and honor; lilies which we use during the Easter season are a royal flower that symbolizes purity and refined beauty; orchids represent glorious femininity, refinement, thoughtfulness and mature charm; finally, the queen of all flowers, the rose, symbolizes passionate love (different colors also mean different things such as a single red rose means "I love you," white is purity and secrecy, dark pink is a way of expressing thanks, light pink is admiration, and my favorite, yellow, represents friendship). You may know other versions, but the mighty rose has so many variations. Whenever I see flowers, I think of the Most Holy Virgin Mary. Thus, for me, one can never have enough flowers. It is beautiful to be surrounded by the Virgin Mary. Another thought comes to mind when Mother Teresa said when asked about whether the world was too overpopulated, she said that saying there were too many children was like saying there are too many flowers in the world. When you receive, or see some flowers: greet your Mother, Our Lady with joy! She is the flower of all flowers; the perfect rose whose fragrance is the scent of pure holiness. Ralph Waldo Emerson said, "Many eyes go through the meadow, but few see the flowers in it." Notice the perfection of God's art and you will never be disappointed.

THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS
