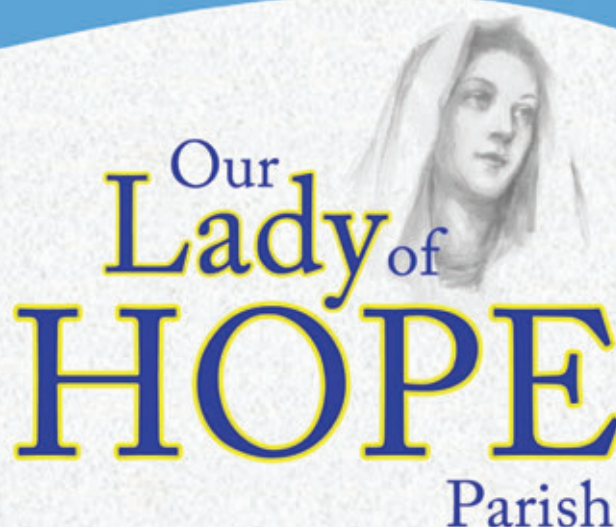

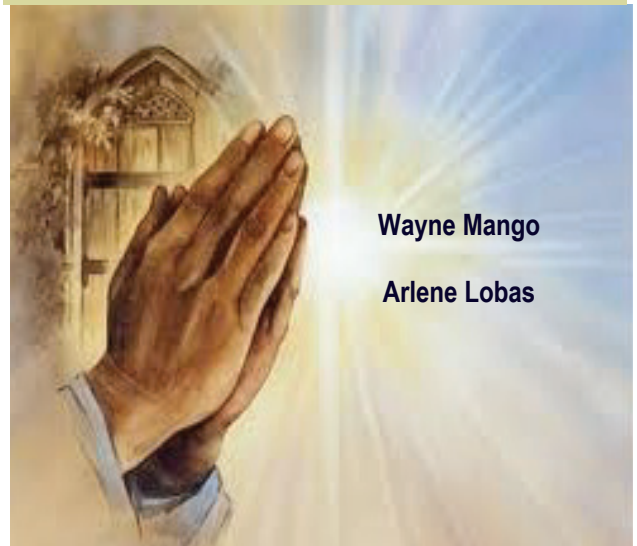

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy Memorial Day Weekend to everyone. We bow our heads in prayer out of respect, admiration and gratitude to the men and women who gave their lives for the freedoms that we enjoy in this nation. I pray that the tension and anger that we suffer in our country at this time will not see us lacking in respect for the price that so many have paid for this country. Approximately 1,304,684 have given their lives in our wars. Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord. Bless their families who also suffered so much at the loss of their loved one. On May 31st, we will only have one Mass for Memorial Day. This will be at 9:00 AM in the church. It is most admirable for us to not only enjoy a picnic, but to take time to honor the best of our nation.

We have also received updated directives regarding the lifting of Covid-19 restrictions. These were directed by our Vicar General. Most importantly: "Beginning with the Vigil Celebration of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), Saturday, June 5th, the faithful are once again *obliged* to participate in Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation." Beginning Friday, May 28th, the mandate for wearing a mask at Mass is lifted. Certainly, one can wear a mask whether they have been vaccinated or not. Ushers are not going to questions anyone about whether or not a person is vaccinated. As always, make well-formed decisions for yourself and others. All mandatory social distancing is lifted, but should one wish to sit away from others, our church is certainly big enough to allow for this. All ministries are allowed to function. As of June 4th, we will begin the offertory procession once again. We will discontinue distributing Holy Communion outside of Holy Mass (3:00 PM on Sunday). When Holy Communion is distributed, we will still sanitize our hands beforehand, but the little table stations will be removed. The diocesan memo mentions that live streaming of the Mass may be continued at one Mass on Sunday. We will continue to live stream the Mass every day at 9:00 PM until discussion takes place with the Parish Council. The diocesan memo indicates no need to livestream the daily Mass. This is under consideration for Our Lady of Hope Parish as we want to use our equipment to reach the homebound.

I am so grateful to all who helped us to manage the restrictions at Mass: Jim McGovern (I could never thank you enough), Fran Lillo, Our Lady of Hope Parish Council, all of our ushers and those who week after week sanitized our pews. In a sense, everyone was involved, as it cost a great deal of money to buy sanitizer, gloves and masks over these months. Thank you for all who made sacrifices and for all who remained faithful during this trying time.

On May 28th, I celebrated 33 years as a priest. The Lord has blessed me beyond anything I deserve. I am so grateful to be your pastor, to serve with the priests and deacons of our parish, to work with a fantastic staff, to be pastor of a great school and I pray for grace as I attempt to live up to being your spiritual father. I always have you in my heart in prayer and know that I love you.

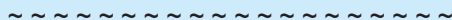
