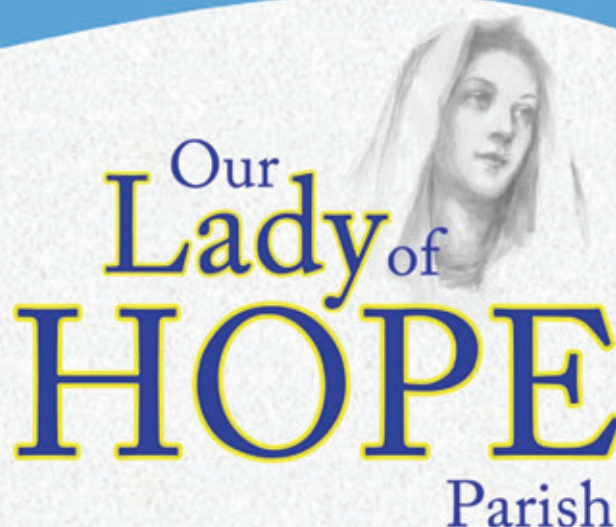

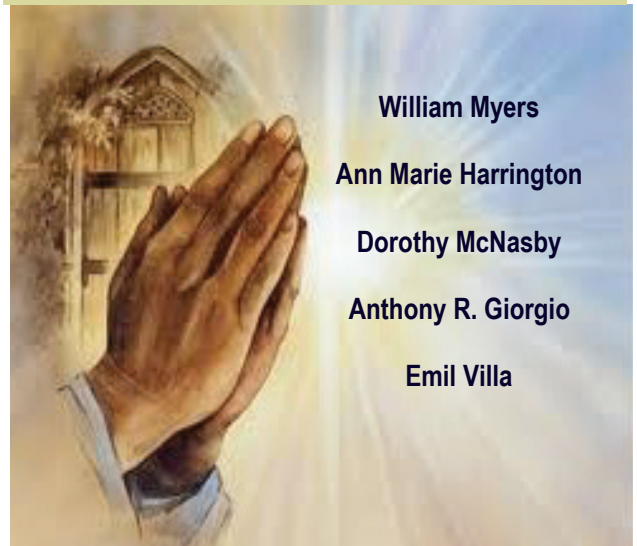

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

This past Monday, June 14th, our nation honored a symbol that should be so dear to us: our flag. For me, this was the beautiful of Flag Days. Our Lady of Hope School carried out the blessing of a new flag pole and bench dedicated to veterans from all the branches of our armed forces in the United States in the front of the school. The Master of Ceremonies was our police chief, Deacon David Harkins, who introduced Father March, a Captain in the United States Marine Corp and graduate of the United States Naval Academy. Father offered a moving prayer and blessing for our flag pole and bench. Mr. Bill Simpson read a poem about the flag and a new flag was presented by Mr. Vincent Foschini from the Knights of Columbus Bishop Schad Assembly 2843. Our first grad opened with "This Land is Your Land" and our Kindergarten sang "Grand Ole Flag." Our Mayor, David Mayer, was present along with numerous police officers, Knights of Columbus, Veterans and the faculty, staff and students of our school. Our principle, Mrs. Elizabeth Martino, spoke about the young man who inspired this special day: Michael Little. We are so proud of Michael Little who oversaw the installation of the flag pole and bench as part of his Eagle Scout project. Michael also saw that each classroom received a new flag and he went into the school to speak in the classrooms about flag etiquette. Thank you so much Michael! We look forward to your being an Eagle Scout. Sherry Smothermon-Short writes, "The Eagle Scout rank shows that a Scout embodies Scout BSA qualities of trustworthiness, loyalty, helpfulness, friendliness, courteousness, kindness, obedience, cheerfulness, thriftiness, bravery, cleanliness, and reverence. Eagle Scouts embody the Scout Law and that makes them a person of strong character. These traits will help them in everything they do, from being a partner to a parent and an employee to a community leader." I very much see these qualities in Michael which is a credit to his parents, Kevin and Trish (active parishioners), to his grade school, Our Lady of Hope and to his high school, Saint Paul VI. Keep up the great work Michael! I pray that Michael will inspire us all to be spiritual eagles: wings represent our faith and belief in God and the air represents the Holy Spirit. May we all reach the heights of the spiritual life. Patriotism is a love for one's country and this is a good virtue to possess when one lives in a free and moral country. As we honor our flag on the property of our school and our parish, may it remind us to vote and do all we can to uphold Christian principles upon which our nation was created. We recently celebrated Memorial Day which called us to pray for those who gave their lives for our freedoms. There are sad things about our country that break our hearts such as the legalized slaughter of innocent babies in the womb, but there are so many things about our nation that has us thanking the Lord for our citizenship in this great land and for the blessings that it brings. As written, "The stripes represent the original thirteen Colonies and the stars represent the fifty states of the Union. The colors of the flag are symbolic as well; red symbolizes hardiness and valor, white symbolizes purity and innocence, and blue represents vigilance, perseverance and justice."
