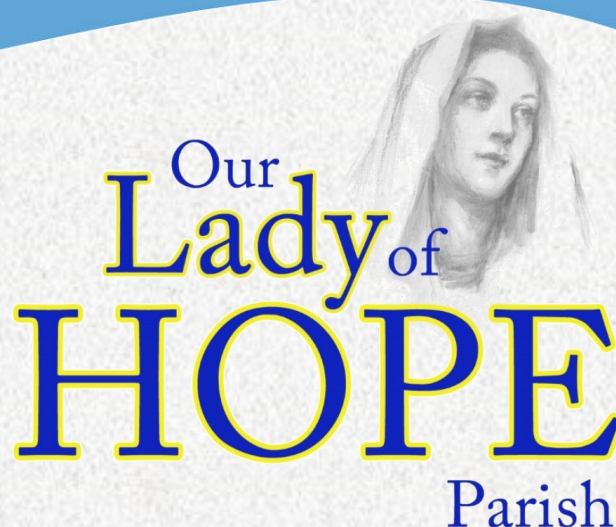

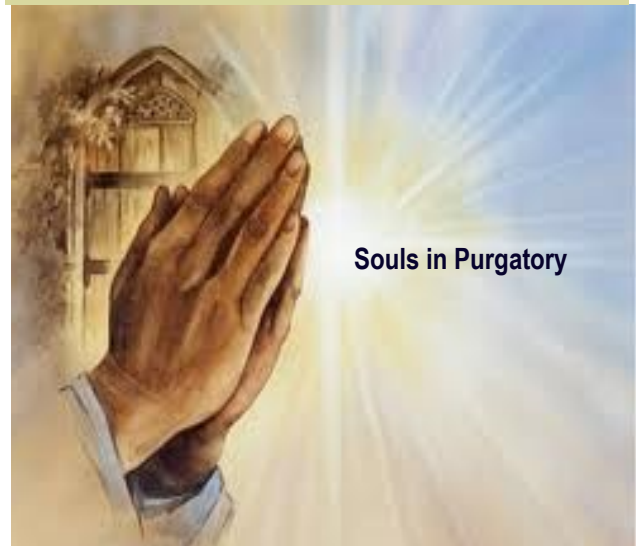

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

This past Monday, a great group met to plan an annual event in our parish: Our Lady of Hope Carnival. August 26-28, 2021 will see our Carnival with God willing great weather and lots of people. By August, I am confident that we will look forward to enjoying time as parishioners and seeing others from the outside come onto our “Blessed Mother’s sanctuary of love.” With all the restrictions, we were unable to have the Carnival last year and so this one will be special. The leadership of this Carnival is so wonderful and I am so grateful for all they do. There is a core group that continues this tradition in our parish and we sure enjoy working together. There will be rides, food (both traditional American and Latino food), music, a beer garden, games, chances and the ever beloved funnel cake. The cooking is shared by Our Lady of Hope parishioners including our good friends from Saint Jude’s (Father Rene will make an appearance, I am sure!). Buen provecho! There will also be the novelties of deep fried Oreos and chilled pickles on a stick. You will be hearing more about the Carnival over the weeks to come and how you can make donations of food and condiments or how you can volunteer to help. In the meantime, pray to Saint Julian the Hospitaller, who is the patron of carnival workers, for good weather and that he would ask the Lord to bless our Carnival this year. Saint Julian has a strange history: according to *Catholic Online*, “Reported in the Golden Legend, Julian slew his noble [parents](#) in a case of mistaken identity. He believed his wife was with another [man](#) and struck them both. His wife returned home from church soon after. In penance, Julian and his wife went to Rome. Returning after receiving absolution, Julian built an inn and a hospital for the poor. He even put a leper into his own bed. That leper was an angel.” His conversion and care for the poor brought him to forgiveness and to a saintly life. Interestingly, there is great devotion to Saint Julian in Malta. I am going to ask Sister Dorothy to intercede for the Carnival along with Saint Julian. There is a saying that “Carnivals bring out the child in everyone.” Jesus tells us “Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.” (Matthew 18:3). Everything is about evangelization, even our Carnival. All for the glory of God! Get excited...for the Carnival is coming to Blackwood at the end of August!

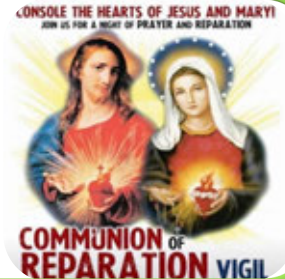

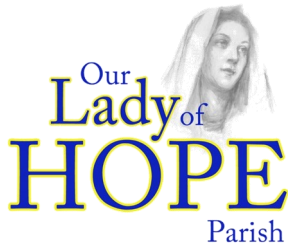
