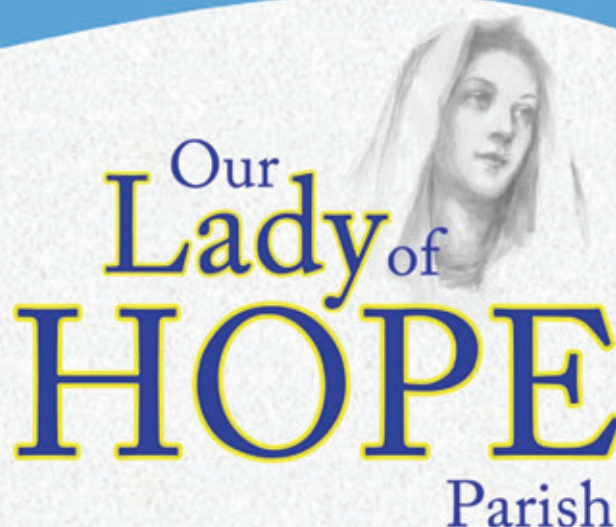

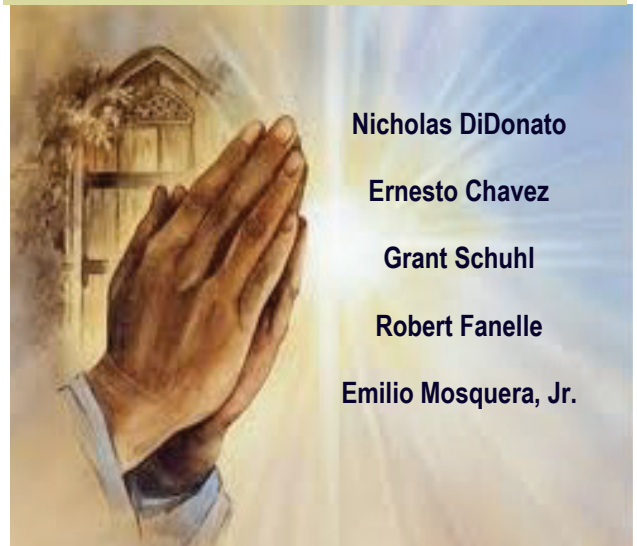

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today is July 4th or Independence Day for our nation. I believe that it is a day for all Americans to give thanks to the Lord for the blessings that He has bestowed upon our land. There is a great deal of criticism about the United States of America and yet, it is the greatest nation on earth. The division that our nation is suffering is so sad. But there is always hope...always. As I noted before we recently had one of our young men, Michael Little, put up a flag pole at our school as his Eagle Scout project. It is so wonderful to see such patriotism which is core to the Scouts of America. Kevin Reilly just became an Eagle Scout which is a coveted honor, with deep meaning reflecting love for God and country. The Church calls us to see the dignity in every human being: from the baby newly conceived until the person dying to this life. Life is a gift that we must defend on every level. We are a good people. Our country is still a beacon of hope for many as we see waves of people wanting to come to this great land. If things are so terrible, why would so many want to come here?
