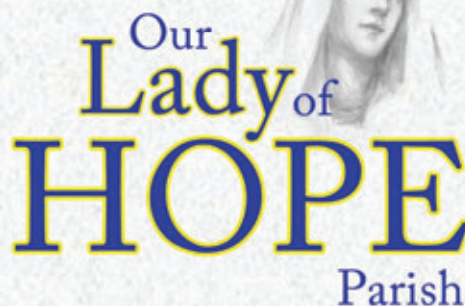

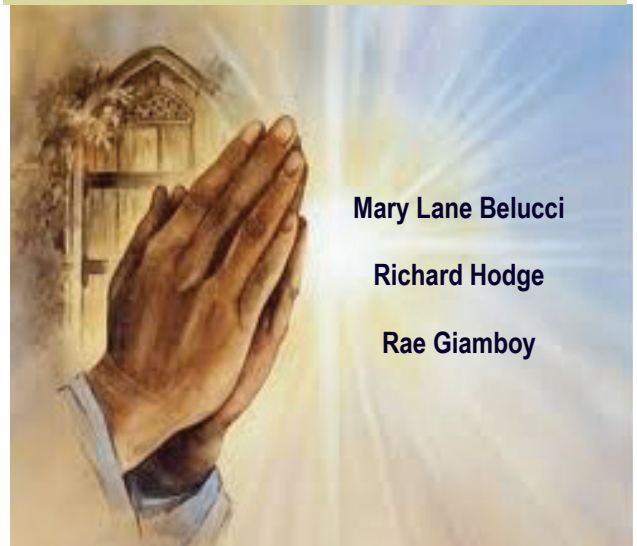

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

Saint Paul tells us in Sacred Scripture: “All this I do for the sake of the Gospel, so that I too may have a share in it. Do you not know that the runners in the stadium all run in the race, but only one wins the prize? Run so as to win. Every athlete exercises discipline in every way. They do it to win a perishable crown, but we an imperishable one. Thus I do not run aimlessly; I do not fight as if I were shadowboxing. No, I drive my body and train it, for fear that, after having preached to others, I myself should be disqualified.” (1 Corinthians 9:23-27). Living in the Hellenistic world, Paul would have understood the theory of the Olympic Games and the impact of the body on Greek culture. Thus, his use of athletic imagery is one that would reach beyond the centuries into our own time when people tend to worship more in a stadium than in a house of God. Every day there is news concerning the doings in Tokyo at the Summer Olympics. I can remember being glued to the television cheering for Americans and hearing the personal stories of the athletes that were truly an inspiration. I have not gotten into the events this year for many reasons: among them a lack of time and the politicization of the games which is a turnoff for me, but there was a story that caught my attention. When a Filipina won the first Gold Medal for the first time for her country, I wrote to Deacon Andy. Deacon Andy wrote back with something even more impressive. Hidilyn Diaz won the Gold Medal in women’s weight lifting, but more importantly, Hidilyn also wore a silver medal! Did she win it lifting weights? No, she was wearing her Miraculous Medal on her neck along with her Gold Medal. Way to give glory to the Lord by honoring His Holy Mother, Mary! If that was not a signal grace for all to see, let us recall that August also begins the month dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our Lady at Fatima assured Lucia: **“My Immaculate Heart will be your refuge and the way that will lead you to God.”** I want to say that we can never love Our Mother enough. She will always, under all circumstances lead us to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Many people continue to pray at our grotto bringing their joys and sorrows to the feet of Our Lady. I love seeing the steady stream of faithful living the sign to the entrance of the grotto, **“To Jesus, through Mary.”** Yes, Hidilyn Diaz worked hard for her Gold Medal and it is well deserved, but more importantly it is her Silver Medal, the Miraculous Medal that is eternal. Wearing this medal (which I always do) is a sign of belonging to the Blessed Mother. In 1830, Our Lady appeared to Saint Catherine Laboure at Rue du Bac in Paris. This Sister was given an image to be struck as a medal which had a picture of the Holy Mother, the Hearts of Jesus and Mary and surrounding the medal were the words, **“Ô Marie, conçue sans péché, priez pour nous qui avons recours à vous”** (“O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee”). There is more on the medal such as twelve stars, the letter M, etc. It is called miraculous because of the way that devotion spread so wonderfully. Devotion to Our Lady means loving the Lord, His Real Presence, His Church, the Sacrament of Confession, praying the Holy Rosary and above all, heeding her advice at Cana: **“Do whatever He tells you.”** Also, if you have not been to the *Shrine of the Miraculous Medal* in Germantown, you are missing out. It is beautiful. The address is 500 E. Cheltenham Ave, Philadelphia, PA 19144. So, let us run the race in order to win **“an imperishable crown.”** Way to go Hidilyn! Way to wear the medal that will help you get to heaven!

Although the Church earnestly recommends the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed, it does not however, forbid cremation unless it has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching. Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form. We should honor them as we honor the body. They must be reverently buried or entombed in a place reserved for the burial of the dead.
