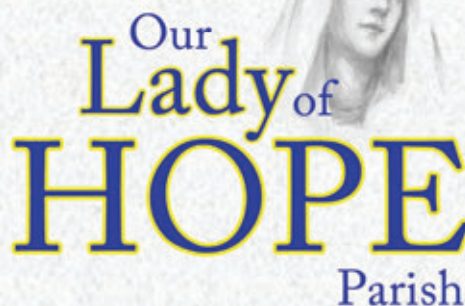

## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*

Dear Friends in Christ,

This is Carnival Week! The committee has been working hard to prepare for our wonderful, outdoor activity celebrating God's gifts to us. So many have noted that they are looking for something to do on our parish grounds. This weekend is the Feast of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Our Lady is so present on our very grounds that have been consecrated to Jesus in honor of His Holy Mother. Come out to the Carnival this week: Thursday through Saturday (August 26<sup>th</sup> – August 28<sup>th</sup>). Again, the Virgin Mary makes her presence known in that the first day of the Carnival is providentially the Feast of Our Lady of Czestochowa! I am dedicating this year's Carnival to the Black Madonna, Our Lady of Jasna Gora. Come to Our Lady of Hope grounds to enjoy rides, games, raffles, good food (Latino as well! Although the Church earnestly recommends the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed, it does not however, forbid cremation unless it has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching. Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form. We should honor them as we honor the body. They must be reverently buried or entombed in a place reserved for the burial of the dead. When choosing cremation, there are many choices available including:

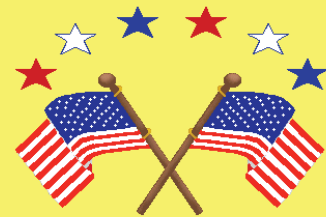
