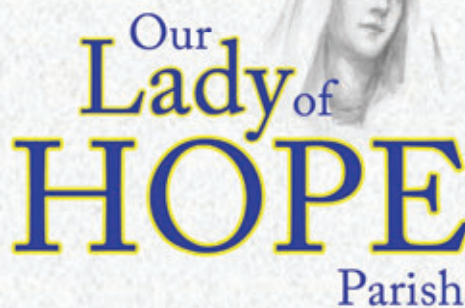

"If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all." MARK 9:35

Jesus teaches His Stewards that they are called to love one another. Love involves sacrifice. Sacrifice is a word that many of us don't like to hear. We think it means that we must give up something that we want. However, the literal meaning of sacrifice is "to make holy," from the words "sacer" = sacred and "facere" = to make. In other words, we make our lives holy by sharing our gifts in the service of God.

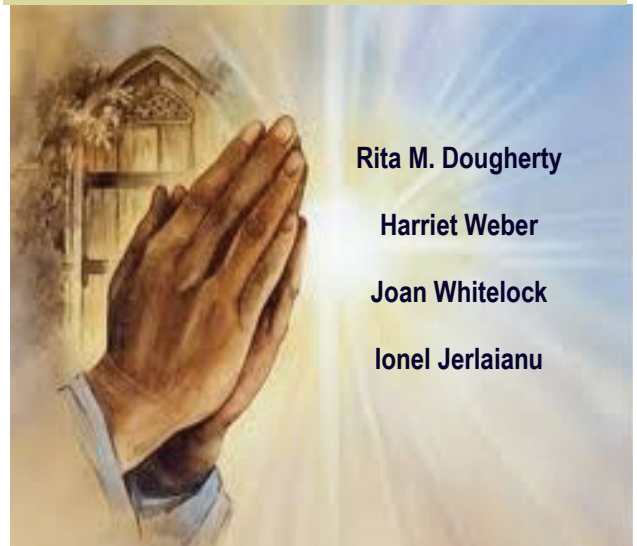

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary and we are looking forward to honor Our Mother and Queen. On October 4th, the Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi, our parish will begin a *Perpetual Novena in Honor of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal*. Beginning that first Monday in October and then continuing every Monday from then on, we will gather for prayer. We will pray the Holy Rosary at 6:30 PM and then the Novena will begin at 7:00 PM. The Most Blessed Sacrament will be exposed; there will be an announcement of favors received; we will then pray the Novena prayers; followed by a homily and ending with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. The Novena will never be more than an hour. Novenas are very traditional and they derive from the nine days that the disciples and Our Lady gathered in the Upper Room awaiting the descent of the Holy Spirit. Novenas have consisted of nine years, nine months, or most commonly, nine days. Please come out and join us on Mondays to honor the Holy Mother of God who appeared to Saint Catherine Laboure and revealed the Miraculous Medal which was first cast in 1832.

Something else that we are beginning will be monthly recordings to be viewed on our website around various aspects of the faith. Father March and I will sometimes be together or alone on the website discussing various aspects of the faith. We will also have guests come and speak with us on matters of the faith. Our first recording will be created on September 24th and will be posted after a little editing. It will be nothing high tech, but this will hopefully be another way of teaching the faith. We look forward to your thoughts once we get under way. Please pray for both of these endeavors that they would please Our Lord, express our love for the Holy Mother of God and that we will transmit the teachings of the faith in a clear and uncompromised way.

Finally, I express great joy at the beatification of Stefan Cardinal Wyszynski! Along with Pope Saint John Paul II, he has truly been an inspiration to me. His episcopal motto is *Soli Deo* (*To God alone*). He and Saint John Paul gave everything to Jesus through Mary. May these holy men pray for us and inspire us to do the same!

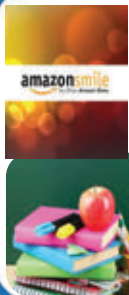

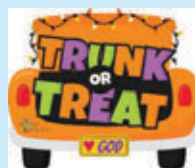
