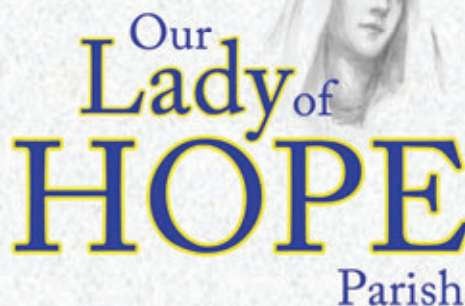

## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*

Dear Friends in Christ,

It is a wonderful thing in our parish that we have prayer groups. So often, people may not be aware of the amount of prayer that takes place on our parish grounds. We just had the 2000 Hail Mary group meet to pray at the grotto; our Flames of Fire Charismatic Prayer Group is undergoing a Life in the Spirit Seminar; every First Friday, there is the Alliance of the Two Hearts (Jesus and Mary) which has a Mass at 7:00 PM on First Friday in honor of the Sacred Heart followed by confessions. During the confessions there are constant prayers and singing before the Exposed Blessed Sacrament. At 12:00 Midnight, for First Saturday, there is a Mass celebrated in honor of Our Lady's Immaculate Heart. There is a little prayer group that prays on Thursdays in honor of the Most Precious Blood and there are a few other prayer groups that get together to intercede for our parish and the world. These special moments are in addition to all of the people that come and go every day to pray in our chapel or to go to pray at the grotto lighting a candle in prayer. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament takes place every Friday from after the 9:00 Mass until Benediction at 7:00 PM. Adding to these moments of prayer will be our Novena in Honor of the Miraculous Medal which will begin on Monday, October 4<sup>th</sup>. We will start with the Holy Rosary at 6:30 PM. Our times call for prayer. Our Church needs the aid of Heaven as does our nation and the whole world. Our Lord tells us numerous times to not be afraid. As long as we are with God, all will be well as Saint Hildegard of Bingen would say. The devil wants us to be afraid, but while his influence is strong, he is not God and is in no way on the level of Jesus. Prayer can change all things. It is important to gather with like-minded people so that evil one cannot isolate us which can cause us to really become confused. I was recently at the annual New Jersey Right to Life dinner which featured Sarah Huckabee Sanders as the keynote speaker. Wow! Her message was so beautiful and the people at the dinner were filled with joy as we gathered in the name of the Lord to proclaim the sanctity of life allowing Sarah to touch our hearts. To gather in a prayerful spirit with people who are on the forefront of the protection of life from conception to natural death was grace filled. We need to gather in groups to pray and to beg the Lord to grant us the grace to do good and to stop offending Him. Spend time in prayer on Our Lady of Hope grounds. ### **October is the month Of Our Blessed Mother Traveling Statue of Mary**

**Q:** Why does a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary go from home to home in some communities?

**A:** The origin of this custom is the so-called shelter seeking, that is the Holy Family on their way to Bethlehem, seeking a shelter where they could stay for the night, and where Mary could give birth to Jesus. Out of the recollection of this event grew the medieval *Frauen Tragen* (carrying of our Lady) in Germany, and later the so-called Posada (house, dwelling, inn) in Hispanic countries. The custom is a 'spiritual compensation' for the innkeeper's refusal to invite the Holy Family into his Inn.

Altar and Rosary provides a Traveling Mary Statue to parishioners and members of our society who wish to have it in their homes for special intentions, novenas and prayers to the Blessed Mother. 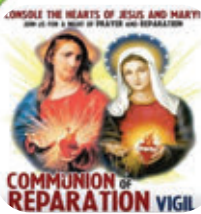
