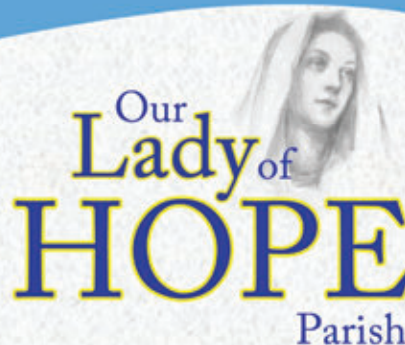

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

We continue to celebrate the Year of Saint Joseph which will officially end on December 8th of this year. We are living in times where we need to call upon this pillar of faith and model of devotion to the Lord Jesus and His Holy Mother Mary. We miss out on so much when we do not consider Saint Joseph in our prayer life. When one loves someone, they love so many of the things that are the object of our devotion. We cannot even imagine how much the Lord loves Saint Joseph! Saint Josemaría Escriva "In human life, Joseph was Jesus' teacher in their daily contact, full of refined affection, glad to deny himself to take better care of Jesus. Isn't that reason enough for us to consider this just man, this holy patriarch, in whom the faith of the Old Covenant comes to full fruition, as a master of interior life? Interior life is nothing but continual and direct conversation with Christ, so as to become one with him. And Joseph can tell us many things about Jesus. Therefore, never neglect devotion to him - *Ite ad Ioseph: "Go to Joseph"* - as Christian tradition puts it in the words of the Old Testament (Gen 41:55)". There is something so solid and comforting when it comes to Saint Joseph. He speaks so much through his silence. Many of the saints had great devotion to Saint Joseph, including the great mystic Saint Teresa of Avila. In her autobiography, chapter 6, Saint Teresa writes, "I only beg, for the love of God, that anyone who does not believe me will put what I say to the test, and he will see by experience what great advantages come from his commending himself to this glorious patriarch and having devotion to him. Those who practice prayer should have a special affection for him always. I do not know how anyone can think of the Queen of the Angels, during the time that she suffered so much with the Child Jesus, without giving thanks to Saint Joseph for the way he helped them. If anyone cannot find a master to teach him how to pray, let him take this glorious saint as his master and he will not go astray." It is interesting that there are those who avoid piety, with little interest in any devotions to the Mother of God or to any of the saints, let alone the great Saint Joseph. Piety is a Gift of the Holy Spirit and like any gift, it can be unused. Devotions bring a sweetness to our spiritual life and the towering figure of the man to whom Our Blessed Lord and Our Lady were entrusted is a gift to us. So many in our parish are expressing great love and devotion to the Blessed Mother which I am confident is pleasing to her Son, Our Lord, as she constantly reminds us "to do whatever He [Jesus] tells us." Saint Joseph is also an inspiration and is clearly aligned with our Mother Mary. Pope Saint John Paul II said of Saint Joseph, "On the other hand, it was from his marriage to Mary that Joseph derived his singular dignity and his rights in regard to Jesus. "It is certain that the dignity of the Mother of God is so exalted that nothing could be more sublime; yet because Mary was united to Joseph by the bond of marriage, there can be no doubt but that Joseph approached as no other person ever could that eminent dignity whereby the Mother of God towers above all creatures. Since marriage is the highest degree of association and friendship involving by its very nature a communion of goods, it follows that God, by giving Joseph to the Virgin, did not give him to her only as a companion for life, a witness of her virginity and protector of her honor: he also gave Joseph to Mary in order that he might share, through the marriage pact, in her own sublime greatness." We still have time to discover this great man, Saint Joseph during his special year. Jesus, Mary and Joseph, help us and keep us close to our Heavenly Father.

October is the month Of Our Blessed Mother Traveling Statue of Mary

Q: Why does a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary go from home to home in some communities?

A: The origin of this custom is the so-called shelter seeking, that is the Holy Family on their way to Bethlehem, seeking a shelter where they could stay for the night, and where Mary could give birth to Jesus. Out of the recollection of this event grew the medieval *Frauen Tragen* (carrying of our Lady) in Germany, and later the so-called Posada (house, dwelling, inn) in Hispanic countries. The custom is a 'spiritual compensation' for the innkeeper's refusal to invite the Holy Family into his Inn.

Altar and Rosary provides a Traveling Mary Statue to parishioners and members of our society who wish to have it in their homes for special intentions, novenas and prayers to the Blessed Mother.
