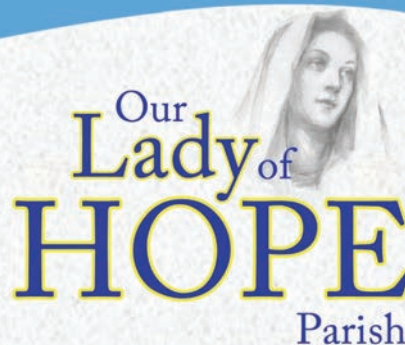

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

We had a very busy weekend at Our Lady of Hope Parish last weekend. On Friday night, we had a Bonsal Blues Concert which was thoroughly enjoyed by so many. Keep watch for the Christmas Concert that they will offer us in the upcoming Advent Season. On Saturday, at 12:00 noon, parishioners and friends gathered at the gazebo in Veteran's Park for a Rosary Rally. This public display of faith led by the Knights of Columbus and assisted by the Altar and Rosary was so beautiful. The Holy Spirit was blowing like mad as evidenced by the strong wind and the feeling of the Lord's joyful presence. Saturday night, the Knights conducted the first Spaghetti Dinner which was a total success and was very delicious. Many people dined in our hall and a great number of people stopped by for takeout. Finally, our parish hosted members of our diocese who gathered with our bishop to involve ourselves in the synod process on the local level. Every pastor was asked to have four of the faithful from the parish to take part in this process. Holy Mass was celebrated by Bishop Sullivan along with the pastors of the diocese. At the end of the Mass, awards were given to people who have given extraordinary service to the diocese. Trudy helps those who are preparing to receive their Holy Sacraments to grow in faith and knowledge in the graces of God. October is the month Of Our Blessed Mother Traveling Statue of Mary

Q: Why does a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary go from home to home in some communities?

A: The origin of this custom is the so-called shelter seeking, that is the Holy Family on their way to Bethlehem, seeking a shelter where they could stay for the night, and where Mary could give birth to Jesus. Out of the recollection of this event grew the medieval *Frauen Tragen* (carrying of our Lady) in Germany, and later the so-called Posada (house, dwelling, inn) in Hispanic countries. The custom is a 'spiritual compensation' for the innkeeper's refusal to invite the Holy Family into his Inn.

Altar and Rosary provides a Traveling Mary Statue to parishioners and members of our society who wish to have it in their homes for special intentions, novenas and prayers to the Blessed Mother. We now extend the invitation to all healthcare professionals to join us in creating a new healthcare ministry. Please contact the Parish Office at 856-228-4331 for more information.

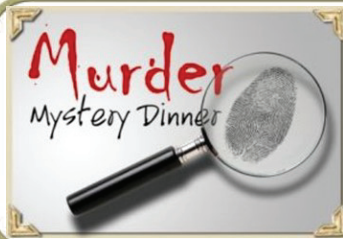

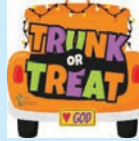
