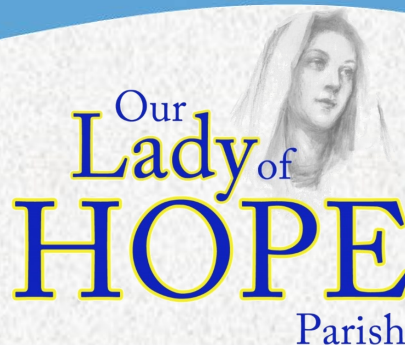

Stewardship Heart

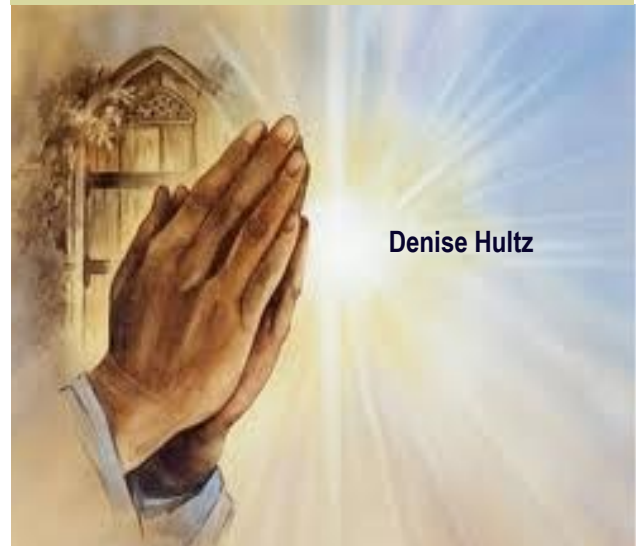

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

In our modern age, the use of technology is very important including our attempts to use tech to further the Gospel. During the height of the pandemic, when we were forbidden to have public Mass, we wanted to stay in touch with you through offering Mass from the chapel in our rectory. It was a saving grace for so many and I assure you, it meant so much to your priests to be in touch have some communication with you. Your comments meant so much to us. It is hard to believe that we were using an iPad on a tripod to send our message via Facebook. We have come a long way in that we installed cameras in the church and in the chapel. This also includes St. Jude Church. This has allowed us to broadcast our Mass every day at 9:00 AM. We also broadcast the Novena in Honor of the Miraculous Medal every Monday. Father March and I are recording monthly discussions which are posted on our website. We also use the cameras for occasions such as funerals, some weddings, and the Blue Mass. We have installed a sound system at our Blessed Mother's grotto so that we offer Holy Mass and have different devotions held at the grotto. During the worst part of the Covid 19 scare, the faithful were relieved from the obligation to attend Holy Mass in person. The obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays is restored and therefore all Catholics are obliged to attend Holy Mass on Sundays. *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* says, "The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation... Participation in the communal celebration of the Sunday Eucharist is a testimony of belonging and of being faithful to Christ and to his Church" (CCC 2181, 2182). As more and more people reject the Mass and claim to be "spiritual" rather than religious, we see that the very core of the Catholic faith is being lost. Regretfully, many go to Mass when they are inclined. Our Lord went to Calvary out of the love for us to save us from sin and death. The Mass is the reliving of the unbloody Sacrifice of Jesus. Our Lord is so lovable, how can we resist not being with Him? Every time we attend Mass we are one step closer to Heaven! The wise virgins in Scripture filled their lamps with oil and were prepared for when the Bridegroom calls. So must we. Empty oil lamps will not get us to the place prepared for us in Heaven. Returning to the discussion of livestreaming the Mass. We received a letter from our Chancery instructing all pastors that beginning the First Sunday of Advent, November 28, 2021, we are to discontinue livestreaming daily Mass. We are still permitted to livestream one Sunday Mass per weekend. We will continue to livestream Sunday Mass at 9:00 AM while curtailing the livestreaming of daily Mass. I know our Bishop is concerned that the faithful will more and more participate at Mass from a distance and he is trying to protect the integrity of the Mass. We plan on using our broadcasting ability whenever permitted as our parish continues to fulfill its mission to "Make Jesus known and loved."

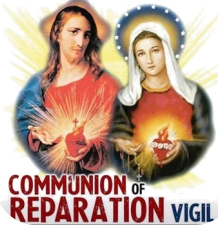

OUR SYNODAL JOURNEY BEGINS

The word “synod” is derived from two Greek words meaning a “coming together” or “travelling together”. Today, it particularly describes an ecclesiastical governing or advisory council a church. In our Catholic heritage, we are most familiar with the Synod of Bishops, a permanent collaborate body established as an advisory board by Pope Paul VI in 1965. Pope Francis has called for a convening of the Sixteenth Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops for a **Synod on Synodality** to be held in Rome in October 2023 but he is also taking the unique step of calling the People of God to active participation in this Synod.

Earlier this month, after an extensive preparatory process, the Holy Father formally convoked “**The Church of God in Synod**” over the next two years calling on all baptized individuals, who are gifted in faith through the Holy Trinity by their Baptism, to be co-responsible contributors in forming consensus decisions regarding the life and mission of the Church rooted in the Spirit of Christ. Last Sunday, Bishop Dennis Sullivan celebrated the Opening Synod Mass for the Diocese of Camden here at St. Agnes’s Church of Our Lady of Hope Parish officially invoking the call to the people of the Diocese of Camden to Synod assembly within their own local parish faith communities.

To that end, Father Szolack as Pastor of this parish, has called upon four members of the parish to accept the role as “listeners and reporters” of what the people of Our Lady of Hope parish what to share in response to some specific questions about what we as a Church (locally, regionally, nationally and universally) are doing right in living our Faith, what we may doing that is counterproductive to Christ’s message and what we can do better to include every one of God’s people as we journey together to bring about and/or enliven the Good News of the Father’s love and mercy to each and every one of His people. The team is working on various avenues to hear from as many people as possible over the next few weeks. We invite you to join us for any one of three general meeting sessions to begin at **7 PM in St. Agnes Church on Thursday Nov 4, 2021, Tuesday Nov 9, 2021 and Thursday Nov 18, 2021** . We ask that you be open, honest and maybe even sometimes courageous in your answers to our questions while being respectful and nonjudgmental to others’ answers. Your comments will be presented to the Diocesan office during the first week in December. Watch the bulletin for more information and opportunities to participate.

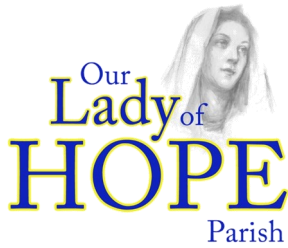
