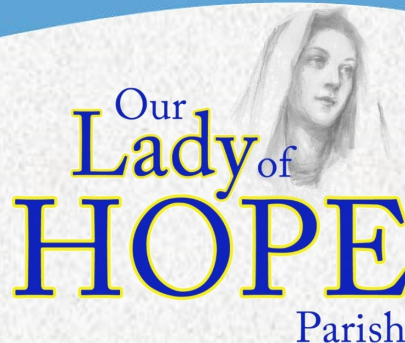

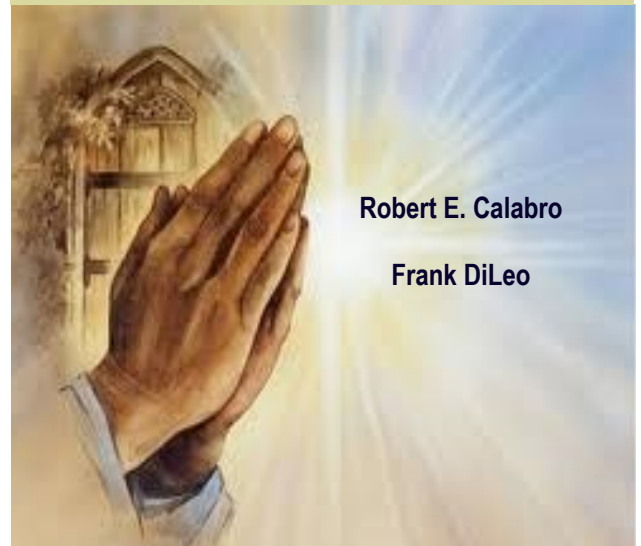

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Recently, Deacon Cesar Pirateque led a session with a small group of Altar Servers. The main point of Deacon Cesar's talk was to help the servers to realize the call that we all have to be holy and how serving at the Altar of God can aid in this quest. Deacon Cesar will host a session *with all* Altar Servers, experienced and new, on Friday, November 12th from 4:30 PM to 6:30 PM. This is an important meeting. Pizza will be served as well as Deacon Cesar showing a short video to inspire us to contemplate what happens at the altar during Holy Mass. I am so grateful to Mary Maupin, who has been the coordinator of Altar Servers for our parish. Thank you Mary for your goodness. Mary will be moving soon enough and I really do not know what we would have done without her these years. Her radiant smile and kindness shown towards our young people have been such a gift. Your legacy will live on Mary! On a side note, you always had a great Polish Easter basket! Our Altar Servers will continue to be trained to be reverent at Mass and help the entire congregation to worship the One, True God. This silent reverence is so essential. I received some letters from faithful parishioners who expressed their dismay at the noise in our church before Mass. It was sad to hear that people come to church early in order to spend precious time before the Lord and they said that it is impossible to commune with the Lord due to the chatter. The church is a place to speak lovingly with God and not with our neighbor. Certainly, I am not encouraging coldness, but the open discussions in church is really loud. I beg everyone to be more disciplined in speaking in hushed tones when speaking is necessary. Jesus wants to hear what is in your heart. A *Catholic News Agency* article said in an article entitled "What Happens at Mass?" said, "Your experience of the Mass will change if you try to get there a little early, so you have time to settle your mind and prepare your heart. Try to enter the sanctuary slowly, reverently and without speaking. Spend a few minutes kneeling and talking to Jesus Christ with real intimacy in the silence of your heart." I do want to chastise, but I can assure you that silence is so conducive to prayer and you will not regret using this time well. Ushers should not talk in the church but only in the vestibule to allow those who sit in the back of the church to be able to pray. We must make ourselves more aware of the Real Presence in our midst. Mother Teresa once said, "God speaks in the silence of the heart. Listening is the beginning of prayer." Silence is truly golden. Our Altar Servers will be working on their piety at the altar; may they help us all to consider our deportment in the Presence of the Lord.

O Lord, Jesus Christ, Eternal High Priest, I thank Thee for the privilege of having served at the holy Altar of Thy sacrifice. Now, as I put aside the garments of that service, I ask that I may at all times think of Thee, and always act accordingly, as a privileged Altar server. May I ever seek Thee and find Thee; may I always follow Thee; may Thy priestly spirit be my guide, and Thy service of love be my example. May Thy Holy Name always be on my lips, and to Thy praise and glory may every work of mine be done. Ever ready in Thy service, may I always know and do Thy Holy Will in all things. May I remain pure and blameless and be found worthy to be Thy servant, and by Thy grace may I persevere to the end. Amen.

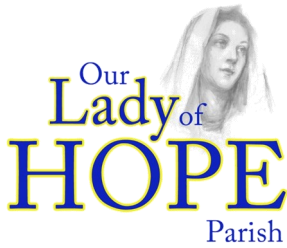
