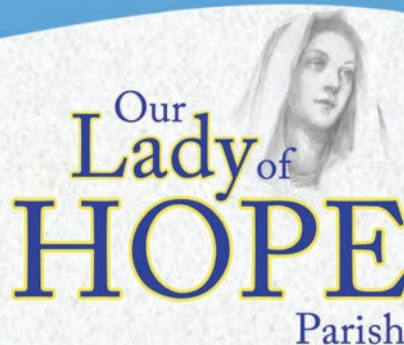

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

As we prepare to celebrate Thanksgiving as a nation, I want to assure the faithful of Our Lady of Hope that I consider it a privilege to serve you and to serve God along with you. As Scripture offers, “I never stop giving thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers. I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, would give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him” (Ephesians 1:16-23). The traditional antidote to selfishness which seems so prevalent in our society is thanksgiving. When we examine our conscience at night, we should spend more time thanking the Lord than going over sins and asking forgiveness. Certainly we need to be aware of our sins and repent, but Saint Ignatius of Loyola reminds us that the blessing, goodness and generosity of God are so much larger than even our foolish sins. President Abraham Lincoln, in a proclamation on October 3, 1863, said “... with humble penitence for our national perverseness and disobedience, commend to His tender care all those who have become widows, orphans, mourners or sufferers in the lamentable civil strife in which we are unavoidably engaged, and fervently implore the interposition of the Almighty Hand to heal the wounds of the nation and to restore it as soon as may be consistent with the Divine purposes to the full enjoyment of peace, harmony, tranquility and Union.” These words apply to our current time. I would think it a time to give thanks for the blessings upon our nation and to put aside this Thursday the anger and negativity that seems to be growing. There is so much strife in the world that despite the challenges in our country, we remain blessed by the favor of Almighty God. On behalf of the priests, deacons and staff of Our Lady of Hope, we wish you a very blessed and enjoyable Thanksgiving holiday.

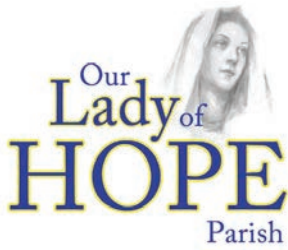
