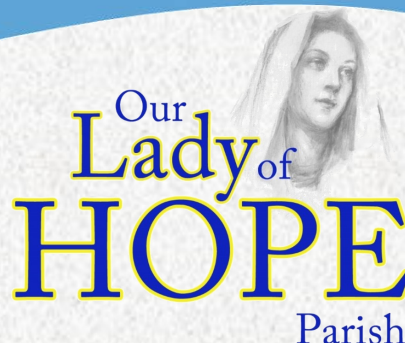

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

While this Sunday is the Third Sunday of Advent or Gaudete Sunday, on the calendar this Sunday is the annual celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe. It is yet another beautiful and mystical title that Our Blessed Mother appeared as to the people of Mexico. Through the wonderful Mexican people, her miraculous image has been preserved and loved since 1531. She is known as the Empress of the Americas: South, Central and North America. We all may have icons, paintings and statues of the Virgin Mary that remind us of our Heavenly Mother, but there is nothing like Our Lady of Guadalupe as this was painted by Heaven on cactus fiber, known as a tilma. I was blessed to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe and to honor her on her feast day, Mary, Mother of God. I offered Holy Mass in the shrine from a balcony chapel that overlooked the sacred image. Our Lady appeared to Saint Juan Diego and she arranged roses on his cape or tilma. When brought to the Bishop, her countenance was viewed until this day. Again, made of cactus fiber! Devotional paint that was applied has fallen off of the painting, but the original image has never left the earth. Someone even tried to blow her image up with a bomb; yet she survived unscathed. When Our Lady appeared to Saint Juan Diego, she said, “No estoy yo aqui que soy tu madre?” “Am I not here, I who am your mother?” This really says it all about who our Mother Mary is to her Son’s disciples. She was first known as “The Perfect Virgin, Holy Mary of Guadalupe.” I love to stay up on the eve of her feast day and watch the Las Mañanitas and the Mass from Guadalupe live into the morning. Of course, we will still celebrate here at Our Lady of Hope Parish with Our Saint Jude’s community. The following is the schedule for Sunday, December 12, 2021:

“Let not your heart be disturbed... Am I not here, who is your Mother? Are you not under my protection? Am I not your health? Are you not happily within my fold? What else do you wish? Do not grieve nor be disturbed by anything.” (Our Lady of Guadalupe to Juan Diego). I do not know how someone cannot love her! ¡Viva Cristo Rey! ¡Viva la Virgen de Guadalupe!

Blessing & Prayers for Advent Wreath



THIRD WEEK *The joyful Sunday in Advent (known as "Gaudete") is represented by rose (or pink) instead of the penitential purple color. Each night during the third week the mother of the family lights the pink, as well as the two previously burned purple candles, after the following prayer has been said.*

Leader: O Lord, we beg Thee, incline Thy ear to our prayers and enlighten the darkness of our minds by the grace of Thy visitation. Through Christ our Lord.
All: Amen.

The three candles are allowed to burn during the evening meals of the third week.

The Third Sunday of Advent marks John Paul II's beloved tradition of **'Bambinelli Sunday.'** St. John Paul II began a tradition where he invited the children of Rome to assemble in St. Peter's Square on the Third Sunday of Advent during his Angelus address. He asked them to bring their little statue of the baby Jesus that would be placed in their Nativity set at home. John Paul II blessed the figurines of those present and told them to assemble before the manger scene with their family in a spirit of prayer. It is a beautiful Advent tradition, one that sanctifies the home with the baby Jesus and makes his arrival in the manger scene an even more joyous event.

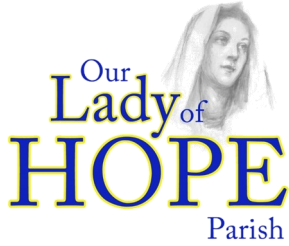
