### The Epiphany of the Lord

#### *Stewardship Gifts*

*"... They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh." (MATTHEW 2:11)*

What gifts do *Stewards* give to the Lord? Pope St. Gregory said that these three gifts represent what we should give God every day. Gold – we should reflect Christ's wisdom in all our relationships. ## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

January is the month that Roman Catholics dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus. To curse someone can be from literally invoking an evil curse upon a person to saying offensive words in anger. It is bad enough that we have become vulgar in society using language in public that would cause the sailors of old to blush. Growing up, I was taught that you did not use bad language, especially in front of a woman. I know that sounds sexist, but it was how it was then. Even priests were not to use bad language. I once used a Polish word that basically meant lazy and a priest from Poland said, "Father, don't use that word, it is low class Polish!" Gulp, I felt like two cents. Using low class language is bad enough in showing a lack of respect for others, but language that is offensive to the Lord is inexcusable. We must avoid using the Lord's name carelessly. Most of us slip and say "O God" too frequently; it is habitual. People who use the Lord Jesus' name or demanding that God damn someone is going over the top. A Catholic gentleman or lady should always defend the honor of God and His Holy Name. There is power in the name of Jesus! Jesus is my favorite word in all the world. I love to hear it and to speak to Him, calling out His name with love and respect. When confessing our sins, we must confess carelessness and downright blasphemy at times. William C. Martin wrote a song about the name of Jesus that offers sentiments for this month dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus:

The name of Jesus is so sweet,  
I love its music to repeat;  
It makes my joys full and complete,  
The precious name of Jesus!

*Refrain:*

"Jesus," oh, how sweet the name!  
"Jesus," every day the same;  
"Jesus," let all saints proclaim  
Its worthy praise forever!

I love the name of Him whose heart  
Knows all my griefs and bears a part;  
Who bids all anxious fears depart,  
I love the name of Jesus!

That name I fondly love to hear,  
It never fails my heart to cheer;  
Its music dries the falling tear,  
Exalt the name of Jesus!

No word of man can ever tell  
How sweet the name I love so well;  
Oh, let its praises ever swell,  
Oh, praise the name of Jesus!

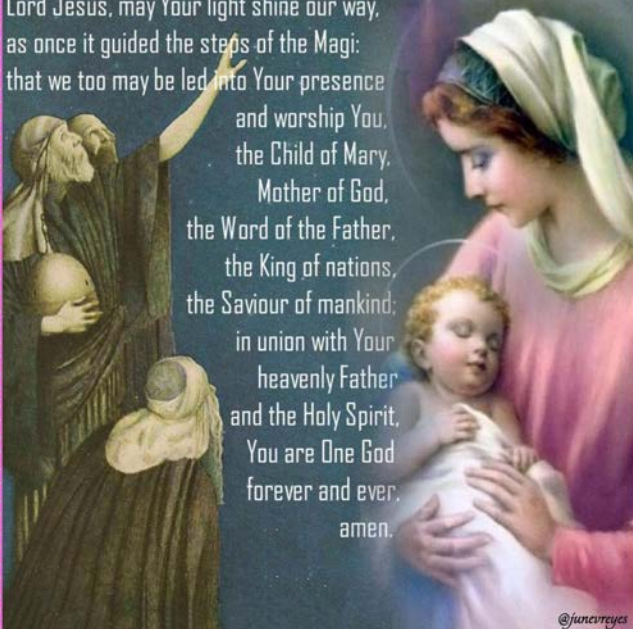

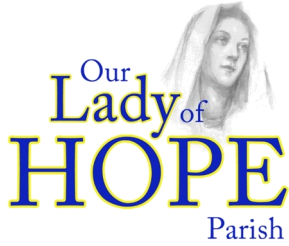
