A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Once again, Happy New Year to everyone! When I was named the pastor of Our Lady of Hope Parish, six years ago, Bishop Sullivan summoned me to his office to give me my “marching orders” for my soon to be new parish. The Bishop, as chief shepherd of all the parishes, keeps a very careful eye on what is going on in the parishes of our diocese. Of the numerous things he shared with me, he stressed that he wanted to see the parish grow spiritually. With all my faults, I am happy that this has been the number one priority of my time as pastor. We will have an opportunity to spend some intensive time with the Real Presence of Jesus January 18 – 20, 2022. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed from after the 9:00 AM Mass on Tuesday, January 18th until Thursday, January 20th. The only time of reposing will be during Holy Mass: 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM every day, but also, every evening there will be a 7:00 PM Mass. On the final night, there will be a procession of the Blessed Sacrament through the church. Our guest homilist will be Father James King. Please see the bulletin for information and we need people to sign up for adoration so that the Holy Sacrament is never left alone. This is always a powerful time of grace for any parish. Amongst so many Catholic teachings, my pillars are the Holy Eucharist, the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Sacrament of Penance. I could not live without them and they do not exist outside the Catholic faith (outside the Orthodox). Jesus says, “Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood, you shall not have eternal life.” The more we adore Him, the more we will grow in faith. The Catholic faith has the answer to Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton’s letter to a friend which showed her longing for the Real Presence. She found Him and she was transformed as our truly America saint. Elizabeth wrote to a friend, “How happy would we be, if we believed what these dear souls believe: that they possess God I in the Sacrament, and that He remains in their churches and is carried to them when they are sick!...how happy would I be, even so far away from all so dear, if I could find You in the church as they do...how many things I would say to You of the sorrows of my heart and sins of my life.” Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton became a great lover of the Most Blessed Sacrament and so must we, if we want to be Catholic, followers of Jesus to the core of our being. Attempting to live without prayer, is like living without oxygen. But can’t I pray anywhere? Of course. I can speak to my mother by telephone, but is it not always better in person? So it is spending time with the Blessed Sacrament. The Forty Hours devotion began with devotion under Saint John Neumann of Philadelphia. He would mandate Forty Hours be celebrated in all the parishes of the then Diocese of Philadelphia. The first Forty Hours after his mandate was carried out in the parish of Saint Philip Neri in Philadelphia. He explained what pushed him to command that Forty Hours be celebrated: “One night, he was working very late at his desk and fell asleep in his chair. The candle on the desk burnt down and charred some of the papers, but they were still readable. He awoke, surprised and thankful that a fire had not ignited. He fell on his knees to give thanks to God for protection, and heard His voice saying, ‘As the flames are burning here without consuming or injuring the writing, so shall I pour out my grace in the Blessed Sacrament without prejudice to My honor. Fear no profanation, therefore; hesitate no longer to carry out your design for my glory.’” May the Lord in His Real Presence be glorified in Our Lady of Hope Parish!

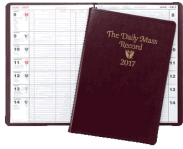

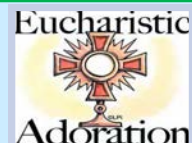

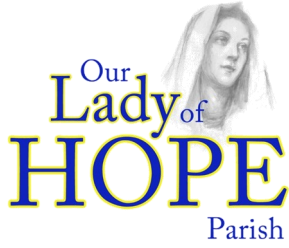
