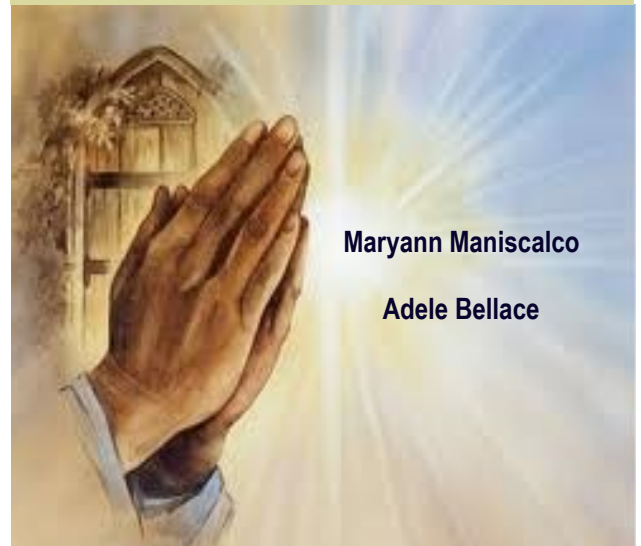

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Beginning this Tuesday until Thursday, we will have our Forty Hours celebration. This is a blessed time for our parish. Mass will be offered Tuesday through Thursday night at 7:00 PM. Our guest priest and homilist will be Father James King. Day and night, for these three days, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration. Saint Peter Julian Eymard wrote, *“Look upon the hour of adoration assigned to you as an hour in paradise. Go to your adoration as one would to heaven, to the divine banquet. You will then long for that hour and hail it with joy. Take delight in fostering a longing for it in your heart. Tell yourself, “In four hours, in two hours, in one hour, our Lord will give me an audience of grace and love. He has invited me; he is waiting for me; he is longing for me.” Such magnificent graces are going to be bestowed our parish on these days! In the Fall of 1916, in Fatima, Portugal, an apparition took place. “When the Angel appeared to the shepherd children he was holding a Chalice in his hands, with a Host above it from which some drops of blood were falling into the Sacred vessel. The Angel left the Chalice and Host suspended in the air, and prostrated himself upon the ground with the children joining him and prayed the prayer: Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I adore You profoundly, and I offer You the Most Precious Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifferences by which He is offended, and by the infinite merits of His Most Sacred Heart and through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg the conversion of poor sinners (The Angel and the children prayed this prayer three times). The Angel then arose, and taking the Host he gave it to Lucia – and to Jacinta and Francisco he gave the contents of the chalice, saying as he did so: ‘Take and drink the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, horribly outraged by ungrateful men. Repair their crimes and console your God.’ Then he prostrated himself once more with the children and repeated the prayer to the Most Holy Trinity three times, then disappeared. Part of the prayer before the Blessed Sacrament is also reparation or asking the Lord for forgiveness for the way He is treated in the Holy Eucharist. He is more than not, received when in mortal sin, a person never going to confession and yet taking of the Sacred Presence. With the wearing of masks and people not lowering their mask, the Host has been dropped numerous times while one attempts to juggle the Sacred Host while trying to get their mask off their ears! It is heartbreaking. The cold, indifference to the Real Presence should cause us to ask for forgiveness. No genuflection or even a casual bow when entering the church and chatting in His Presence. Even at times, during the Consecration, people getting up to run to the restroom or wherever during the time calling for adoration. So, reparation, called for by Our Lady of Fatima, is in order. All this being said, Our Lady of Hope Parish, has some the most wonderful people who love being with Our Lord in His Real Presence. With our chapel open every day, people are in and out in loving prayer. It is so edifying. Let us take time to tell Jesus, over and over, during these Forty Hours that we love Him so much. The last words of the Little Flower were, “Oh! I love Him...My God, I...love...You!” Come to the church and tell Him in person.*

Father Joseph Szolack will be completing his six year term as pastor of Our Lady of Hope Parish, Blackwood. It is the practice in the Diocese of Camden to conduct an evaluation of the pastor before the Priest Personnel Board makes a recommendation to Bishop Sullivan for possibly renewing the pastor's term for an additional six years.

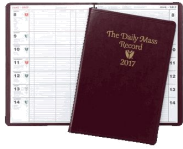

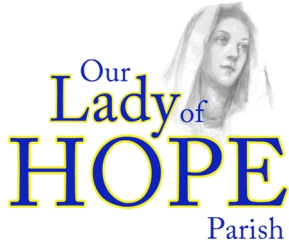
