A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

This past week was so special with our Forty Hours celebration. I expressed at Mass how truly edified I was by our parish. To see streams of people going in and out of the church for days so bolstered my faith. Our church doors were open from Tuesday morning until Thursday night uninterrupted. I know that our parish was so blessed and that good things will come from the hours of prayer that took place during those days. Father March and I boarded a bus for Washington, D.C., that was provided by our Knights of Columbus Council. Friday was the feast of Saint Agnes, patroness of our church, who was a young girl who loved Jesus and gave up her life rather than betray him. Upon waking, I saw that it was 10 degrees outside with the radio saying that it felt like 1 degree! I could only think, what am I thinking! I had been sick and still have a shortness of breath, but the Lord always knows what is best. Since I was a seminarian, I have been going to the March for Life, with few interrupted years. I was fine. We began the day at 6:45 AM with Holy Mass. I doubled my socks and layered clothing as we left for Washington. It was not really bad and the sun was shining brightly. I ran into friends at the March, but more importantly, it was so great to see that the March for Life has clearly become a youth movement! What hope! So many young people see the evilness and lies that are offered through the abortion industry. I refuse to say that our young people are lost or confused. So many sang religious songs, prayed the Holy Rosary and joyfully showed that life is God given and very precious. We had a truly blessed day and I was so blessed to march with people from Utah and Minnesota. I even spent time with a hoard of young people and their chaperones from Saint John Cantius in Chicago, a very special community. The Sisters for Life were in full force as were the Franciscan Friars and Sisters of Renewal. Dominicans and Franciscans were present and I was able to greet the seminarians from Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary, Philadelphia. Yes, God is so great and the battle is far from over. We may have the elderly CEOs of clinics and politicians who make millions from the destruction of life, but the Lord will have His day and may He be praised every time a baby is conceived. God bless those who continue to work at crisis centers to help mothers who want their children despite being in very difficult circumstances. We applaud them and look to their children to do great things. Down at the rally, I recall marching behind a young person who was not even alive during President Reagan's presidency. Her sign quoted the late president, "I've noticed that everyone who is for abortion has already been born." Wow, a lot said in one sentence. Keep praying!
