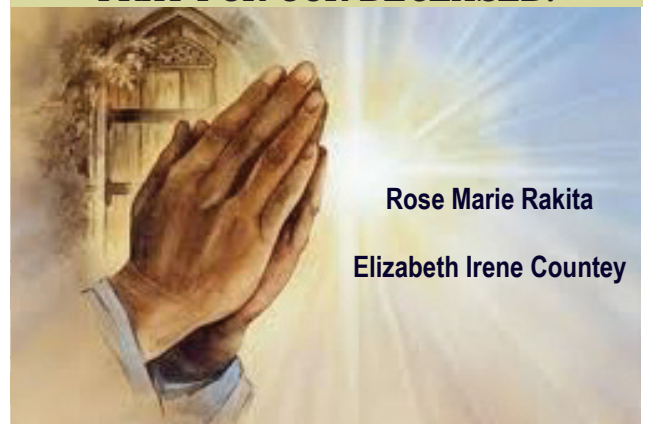

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

The rigorous, holy season of Lent will be upon us this Wednesday, March 2nd. We celebrate Ash Wednesday which will kick off a season that calls us to examine and reform our lives. The examination is to hold ourselves up to the person of Jesus Christ the Lord. How much do we resemble Him in the way He calls us to live our lives? These are special days coming up and we must not waste one minute. Plan your Lent: perhaps daily Mass, Confession, praying the Holy Rosary, reading Sacred Scripture or giving up a favorite food. The traditional threefold program given in the Bible is worthwhile, namely, prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops reminds us: "Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence meaning no meat. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Be rigorous this Lent; let us not baby ourselves, but let us pray, fast and be generous with our donations. What a perfect time to make your House of Charity contribution! Our entire parish family will remain in my prayers as we all enter into the mystery of the Lenten Season in preparation for the celebration of the victory of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ over sin and death! Saint Ephraim the Syrian wrote, "O Lord and Master of my life, take from me the spirit of sloth, faintheartedness, lust of power, and idle talk. But give rather the spirit of chastity, humility, patience and love to your servant. Yea, O Lord and King, grant me to see my own sin and not to judge my brother, for You are blessed from all ages to all ages. Amen." This Lent, O Lord, help us to change.

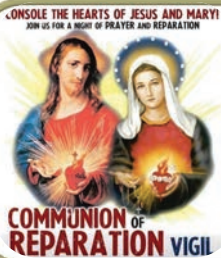

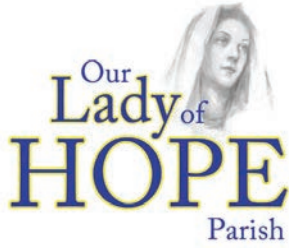
