## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*

Dear Friends in Christ,

As every month is dedicated to a particular devotion, it is a joy to celebrate Saint Joseph for whom the month of March is given. St. Alphonsus Liguori gave us the following litany:

Go, then to Joseph, and do all that he shall say to you;  
Go to Joseph, and obey him as Jesus and Mary obeyed him;  
Go to Joseph, and speak to him as they spoke to him;  
Go to Joseph, and consult him as they consulted him;  
Go to Joseph, and honor him as they honored him;  
Go to Joseph, and be grateful to him as they were grateful to him;  
Go to Joseph, and love him, as they love him still.

There are no words from his lips in Sacred Scripture, yet his actions preached over and over. As we begin this month of Joseph and enter into our Lent, silence is something that is necessary to have a deep prayer life. Mother Teresa would say, "The fruit of silence is prayer." There is certainly a lot of noise in our lives that can distract us from finding the Presence of God. Perhaps we can appreciate silence more, praying in the church and chapel *in silence*. We talk, talk and talk...too often, we do not listen. We may be surprised how much we advance in the spiritual life if we quiet our environment as much as possible. A bank of candles at the great shrine to Saint Joseph in Montreal reminds us, "Go to Joseph." If we want to understand his secret, we will find it in holy silence. Have a blessed beginning of Lent. We hope to see you on Fridays at the Soup and Scripture and at the Stations of the Cross. An important part of Lent is repentance and the holiest and most profound way to repent is to confess your sins to the priest, an instrument of God. It is important to not merely hope we are forgiven, but rather, to know we are forgiven for the Lord promised this. We have the usual times for confessions on Saturday: following the 9:00 AM Mass and at 3:30 PM. During Lent we have the added times for confessions on Mondays at 6:00 PM and on Wednesdays at 7:00 PM. May the great Saint Joseph aid us in our quest for holiness. We do so in silence before the All Holy One.

### PARISH FINANCE COUNCIL UPDATE

The Parish Finance Council acts as an Advisory body to the Pastor and operates under the norms of Canon Law. The Council meets on a monthly basis to review the financial affairs of the Parish. This includes financial reporting, budgeting, and recommendations for expenditures for the upkeep of the parish.

This is the first of what will be quarterly updates on the status of various projects on the sites which constitute Our Lady of Hope Parish and other important issues. Unless indicated for the St. Jude campus, the projects listed are for the St. Agnes campus.

#### Current Projects

- Debt payment of \$20,000.
- HVAC units will be replaced in the Hall and Church\*\*
- New LED lighting will be installed in all buildings\*\*
-

- Bathroom vanities in both the Hall and Church will be replaced.
- New fire alarm system will be installed in all buildings at the St. Agnes campus.
- Meeting rooms in the Hall will be refurbished.
- Video security for St. Jude Church will be installed.

- Debt payment of \$22,804\*
- Exterior LED lighting on entire complex\*\*
- Video security of entire complex
- Tree trimming
- Roof repaired in the back of the Hall
- 12X24 shed acquired and installed for the Carnival Committee
- Repair of trash gates at Hall
- Grotto and dedication to Our Lady \*\*\*

\*\*\*Funds from the Catholic Strong Campaign were used to fund part of this project. The major funding came from a direct appeal to parishioners.

Aside from the Homeland Security Grant money, funding for the upkeep of parish buildings and grounds comes from the generosity of our parishioners either through their weekly contributions to the collection, House of Charity (rebates), and Catholic Strong.
