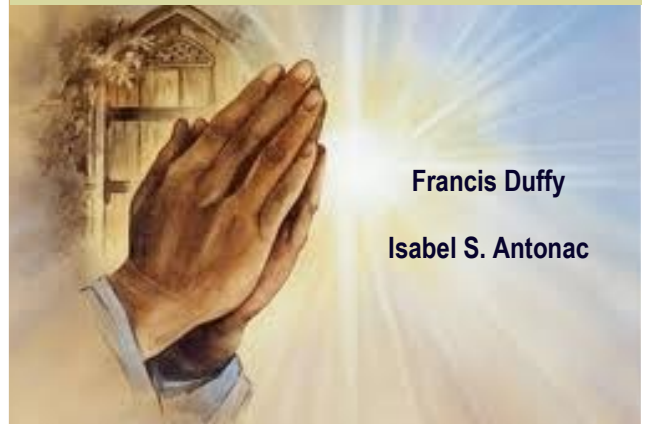

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

This past Friday, we had a wonderful group for our Soup & Scripture and then Stations of the Cross. I was so proud of our parish and it is showing me the spiritual depth of our parish. Please continue to come out for these opportunities. Our theme for the Soup & Scripture are the Opening of the Seven Seals from the Book of Revelation. An important part of Lent is going to the Sacrament of Penance or confession. There is a story about Saint John Vianney concerning the confessional. "The amazing thing concerning John Vianney was that a whole parish converted to living the faith. In 1827, a great number of pilgrims visited Ars. People went to Ars from all over France and other countries including America. People wanted the Cure of Ars to hear their confession and to receive spiritual counsel from him. They longed for the confessional to meet a priest who knew souls. St. John could read souls. This is a rare gift not given to every priest. In confessing people this holy man, who had a fundamental knowledge of sin, strove after one thing only – to save souls. It is not easy to remain for hours in a confessional, especially the type of confessional in those days. It was cramped, small and dull. Saint John heard confessions from 13 to 17 hours a day, and could tell a penitent's sins even when they were withheld (not unlike Padre Pio). St. John Vianney was known to cry in the confessional and when he was asked why he wept, he would reply: 'My friend, I weep because you do not weep.'" The world is out of control. One would be blind not to see that as the world rejects God the shadow of evil is growing. The Lord calls us to be "the light of the world." I was driving recently at night and realize that is becoming more and more difficult. A couple of times almost driving over a concrete island was unnerving. Darkness is making me very nervous; how anxious we must be for the dimming of the light. But the Light is never snuffed out. The movie Mother Teresa begins with the words, "There's a light in this world. A healing spirit more powerful than any darkness you may encounter." The Lord is all glory and power; we are called during Lent to find ourselves in Him. Let us pray for one another and do all we can to make this a great Lent, the best ever. Saint John of the Cross said, "Where there is not love, put love and you will find Love." The Lord is waiting for us. As His prodigal children, let us run to His loving embrace. He will protect us and He cannot wait to let us know that there is nothing to fear from the darkness because His Light is in us. President Franklin Roosevelt famously said, "We have nothing to fear, but fear itself." So, let us raise our eyes to heaven and no longer be afraid. Graces are awaiting us in prayer and the Sacraments. Leave your trash in the confessional and be free to live.

PARISH FINANCE COUNCIL UPDATE

The Parish Finance Council acts as an Advisory body to the Pastor and operates under the norms of Canon Law. The Council meets on a monthly basis to review the financial affairs of the Parish. This includes financial reporting, budgeting, and recommendations for expenditures for the upkeep of the parish.

This is the first of what will be quarterly updates on the status of various projects on the sites which constitute Our Lady of Hope Parish and other important issues. Unless indicated for the St. Jude campus, the projects listed are for the St. Agnes campus.

Current Projects

- Debt payment of \$20,000.
- HVAC units will be replaced in the Hall and Church**
- New LED lighting will be installed in all buildings**

Upcoming Projects

- Bathroom vanities in both the Hall and Church will be replaced.
- New fire alarm system will be installed in all buildings at the St. Agnes campus.
- Meeting rooms in the Hall will be refurbished.
- Video security for St. Jude Church will be installed.

Completed Projects

- Debt payment of \$22,804*
- Exterior LED lighting on entire complex**
- Video security of entire complex
- Tree trimming
- Roof repaired in the back of the Hall
- 12X24 shed acquired and installed for the Carnival Committee
- Repair of trash gates at Hall
- Grotto and dedication to Our Lady ***

**The parish applied for and received Grant money from PSE&G for these energy efficient upgrades.

***Funds from the Catholic Strong Campaign were used to fund part of this project. The major funding came from a direct appeal to parishioners.

Aside from the Homeland Security Grant money, funding for the upkeep of parish buildings and grounds comes from the generosity of our parishioners either through their weekly contributions to the collection, House of Charity (rebates), and Catholic Strong. 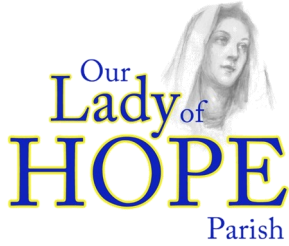

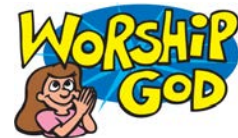


