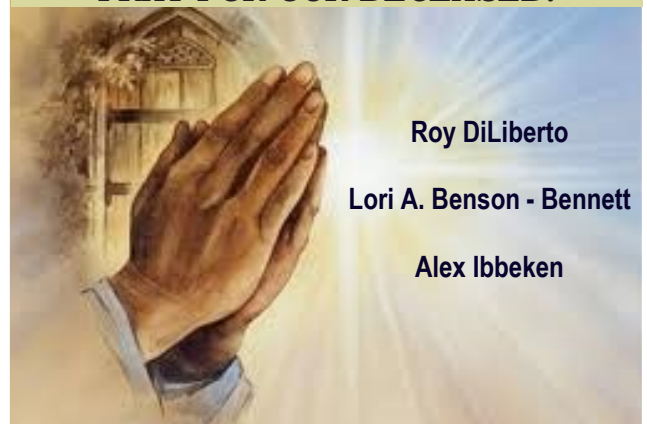

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

It has been announced the Pope Francis will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The Holy Father wrote on Twitter: “On Friday 25 March, during the Celebration of Penance at 17.00 in Saint Peter’s Basilica, I will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. According to the Fatima Center, “The Blessed Virgin’s request for the Consecration of Russia remains one of the most controversial aspects of the entire Fatima Message. While several popes have undertaken consecrations of the world since the request was made public (including Pope John Paul II in 1982 and 1984), sadly, none of these have fulfilled the *specific* requirements of Our Lord and Our Lady’s requests. In repeated visits to Sister Lucy, Heaven’s King and Queen have insisted that it is Russia (and *Russia* only) that is to be the object of this public act of obedience and prayer. In addition, Our Lord and Our Lady have indicated that the Holy Father is to be joined in the act of consecration by *all* the Catholic bishops of the world on the same day and at the same time in their respective dioceses. Interestingly, only Pope Pius XII’s consecration of the world in 1942 included substantial involvement of the bishops. Sister Lucy has written that this *imperfect* act of obedience, while not fulfilling Our Lady’s Fatima request, nevertheless hastened the end of the Second World War, thus sparing the lives of tens of millions of souls.” There definitely seems to be a spiritual and mystical component concerning the conflict in Ukraine. There is always a mystic aspect in the spiritual soul of Russia and thus, this country as the Soviet Union spread Marxist Communism around the world. It is an amazing thing that communism continues to be spread and is thriving in our own nation. The Blessed Mother tells us to “Do whatever He tells you.” As the world becomes more and more atheist or indifferent to God at best, we see the spread of poison throughout the lands. To consecrate something is to set it aside for God’s purposes alone. The Hearts of Jesus and Mary beat as one and thus, when her Immaculate Heart will triumph, we know that this will please her Son who loves His Mother as the most perfect of disciples. The events happening in the world should bring us to our knees, but we shall see. We pray that this consecration of the Holy Father of Russia and Ukraine (which has been said to be the country most devoted to Our Lady) will please the Lord and bring about a swift end to not only the Ukrainian conflict, but may an era of peace be ushered in. O Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us! Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us! Conquer Russia, Our Lady and Our Queen!

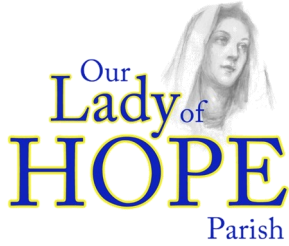




