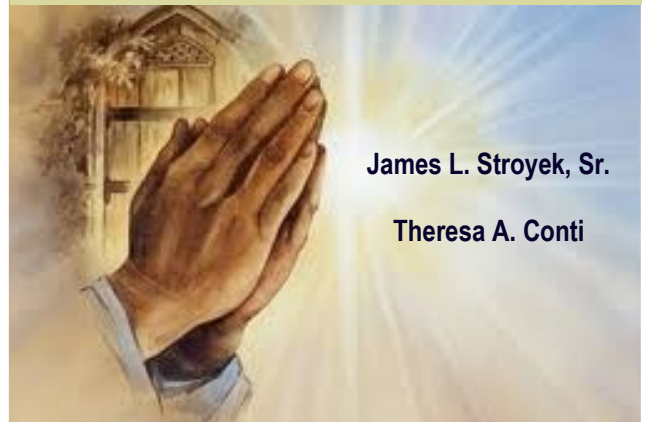

## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

The Lord is blessing our parish in so many ways. The confessions over these past few weeks have been incredible. We have had more confessions than I have seen in years. The Holy Spirit is working overtime in our parish. Our Lady is teaching, we her children, how to love her Son, especially in His Real Presence. Throughout the day, people stream in and out of the chapel, on Friday's so many people love to pray before the Holy Sacrament. Our novena to the Miraculous Medal on Monday nights has been blessed and the Stations of the Cross have had wonderful crowds on these Friday's during Lent. Please remember that there are numerous times for going to Confession. This is important for fulfilling one's Easter Duty and certainly, Holy Communion should not be taken when one is in mortal sin. When in mortal sin it is a sacrilegious Communion. We need to receive the Lord with such love and devotion. Those who snatch the Sacred Host or one handing the Host to pop His Presence into one's mouth is horrific. Please remember to lower your mask when receiving Holy Communion and if receiving in the hand, please consume the Sacred Host immediately. Do not walk away with the Host in hand. Walking away to the side to receive Him is not the proper custom. I bring this up because those who have their mask on are forced to juggle the Host while playing with one's mask. I know that some people are still afraid and thus, wear their mask up to the Minister of Holy Communion, but please lower your mask. There have been too many times that the Blessed Host has been dropped to the ground. It is heartbreaking. How important it is to have profound love and respect for the Blessed Sacrament. Our parish is very Eucharistic and this causes me to rejoice. Continue your Lent, we still have spiritual work to do!
