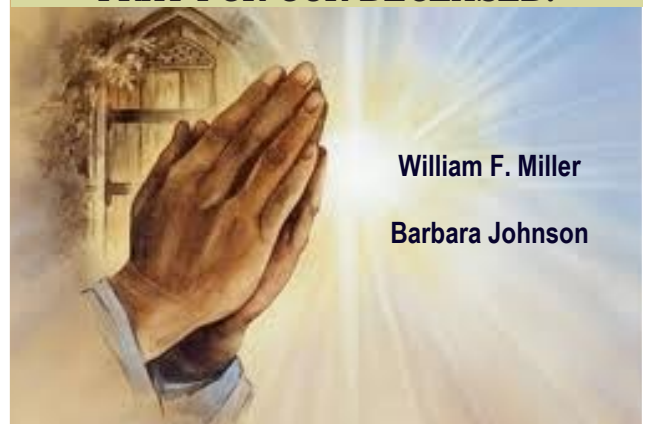

## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

We are now intensifying the Lenten Season. Next Sunday is Passion Sunday or Palm Sunday. We continue to be offering numerous times for one to repent through the Sacrament of Penance. We are hearing many confessions right now and it is a joy to do the work of the Lord. The other day, Father March, Father DeDuca and I were all hearing confessions. I will be you do not see that in many parishes today. We will have one last Lenten Recollection. Our guest speaker will be Dr. Gregory Glasov, who is a professor of Sacred Scripture at Immaculate Conception Seminary. He will speak at the Soup and Scripture at 5:30 PM in the Hall on April 8<sup>th</sup> and then he will offer two more talks on Saturday morning after the 9:00 AM Mass on April 9<sup>th</sup>. The sessions will end on Saturday at 12:00 Noon. Father March and I will be interviewing Father James King about his recent visit to Ukraine. That will be found on our website beginning April 5<sup>th</sup>. I am very excited that the Knights of Columbus are hosting their Palm Sunday Breakfast in the parish hall. It is free! Thank you brothers for your generosity. Please note the Palm Sunday Mass times: 7:30 AM; 8:45 AM; 10:30 AM; 12:15 PM and 6:00 PM. We have ended the Month of March, Dedicated to the great Saint Joseph. April is dedicated in the Catholic Church to the Most Blessed Sacrament. We will be having a Eucharistic Procession on the Feast of Corpus Christi, so keep an eye on the announcements. April is also dedicated to the Divine Holy Spirit and to the Divine Mercy. The Holy Eucharist is the center of our Catholic faith. Please examine your conscience as to how you receive the Lord's Real Presence. Is he received when one is in mortal sin and thus, that person is receiving Holy Communion sacrilegiously? Do we receive Him reverently, lowering our mask in order to not drop the Blessed Sacrament? Do I honor Him in how I dress for Mass? Do I genuflect, if possible, upon entering the church? These are not merely Father Szolack's opinion, but they are customs given to us by the Church. "When you have received Him, stir up your heart to do Him homage; speak to Him about your spiritual life, gazing upon Him in your soul where He is present for your happiness; welcome Him as warmly as possible, and behave outwardly in such a way that your actions may give proof to all of His Presence." – Saint Francis de Sales.
