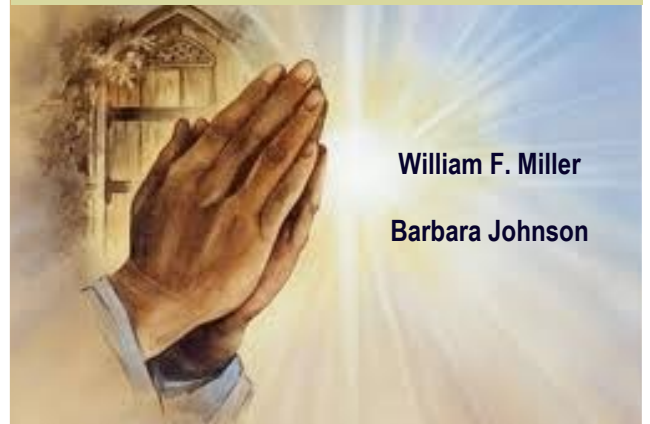

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Our Church throughout the world celebrated Passion Sunday or Palm Sunday as it is most commonly called. We honor the Lord's triumphal entry into the Holy City of Jerusalem where He will enter into His Passion, Death, Resurrection and Ascension into Heaven. The symbol of the palm branch is victory as it is a majestic tree that grows especially beautifully in Jericho and along the banks of the Jordan River. Kings and Queens were welcomed with palm branches and therefore, it is only right that the Lord of Lords, the King of Kings, would be greeted in a manner for royalty. The cries of "Hosanna in the highest" will soon turn to "Away with Him, crucify Him!" Are we not a fickle people? Courtney Love sings in the song "Violet":

"When they get what they want
They never want it again
When they get what they want
They never want it again."

They were crying out for a Savior and yet, when they received Him, they do not accept Him. People want the Lord on a shelf and to take Him down when they need Him. What do we want from Jesus? Jesus, through His incarnation, felt pain, hunger, thirst and rejection. Let us walk with Him this week by coming to Holy Week services and Masses. If we do not have time for Him, we will not find Him when our time runs out. Mother Teresa said, "Never give up on this daily intimate contact with Jesus as a real living person – not just an idea. How can we last even one day living our life without hearing Jesus say "I love you"? – impossible. Our soul needs that as much as the body needs to breathe the air. If not, prayer is dead – meditation is only thinking."

The person who claims to be "spiritual" will remain in the air for the Second Person of the Most Blessed Trinity became a man, founded one true Church and paid the price for each of us so that perhaps, we could be with Him forever in Heaven. Hosanna to the Son of David!
