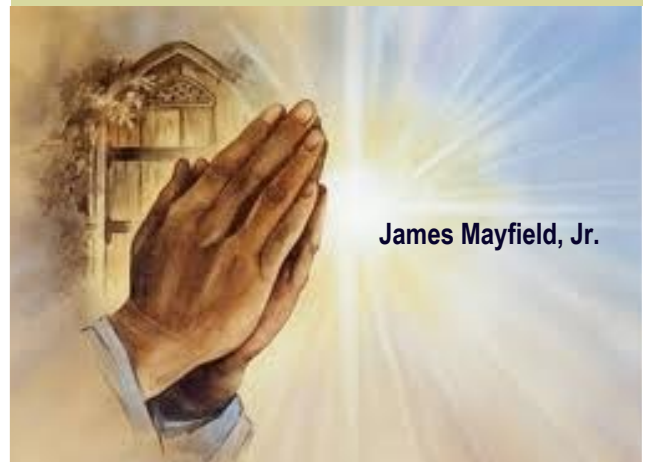

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings on Divine Mercy Sunday! I pray that you had a beautiful Easter and are enjoying the Easter Season. Our celebrations were so special and I am so proud of to be the pastor of Our Lady of Hope Parish! The entire Lenten Season saw so many people coming to confession, our Soup and Scripture was well attended as were the Stations of the Cross. Thank you to all who made soup for our Fridays. It was difficult to choose which soup to eat! My deepest gratitude to all who decorated the church and chapel with flowers. God bless all who donated their resources to allow us to have lovely flowers to adorn the sanctuary. Thank you to Mike Alibrando for overseeing all of our Liturgies, to Andrea for working with the altar servers and our music was really excellent. To the Knights of Columbus (fantastic Palm Sunday Breakfast men! And for being on guard for the Blessed Sacrament on Holy Thursday), our ushers, the Scouts who built our fire for the Vigil, to Norberto who gives so much, including our wonderful outdoor Stations of the Cross performed by the Saint Jude's Youth Group and for Our Lady of Hope Youth Group for having carrying out the Easter Egg Hunt for our little ones. 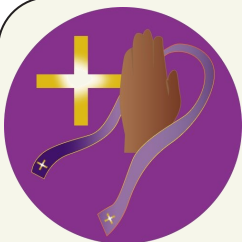

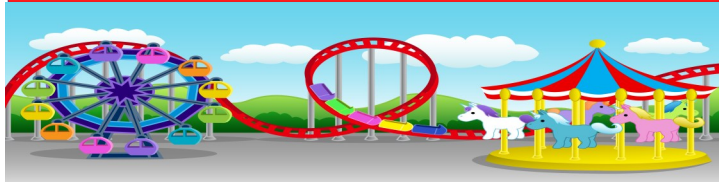
