A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Father John DeDuca came to live at Our Lady of Hope Parish in 2008 at the invitation of Father Mark Cavagnaro. Father was a Senior Priest and then eventually, he lived at Our Lady of Hope as a retired priest. As you know, retirement in the life of Father John was in name only. Father John loves being a priest and carries out ministry on behalf of the Lord with a steadiness and fidelity that can only be called edifying. While I knew Father John prior to my being named the pastor of Our Lady of Hope, I did not know him well. Upon my returning from Colombia and reporting to Our Lady of Hope, Father greeted me at the door and let me into my new home. It has been a gift to work alongside Father John during these past six years. He is a man of culture and spirituality. There have been many conversations at the table around Dostoyevsky, the Romanovs, the history of the Diocese of Camden, iconography, Russia and Italian food. Father John loved visiting the sick whether at hospital or in people's homes. I can still see him pouring over a map for his latest outing rather than use a GPS. Father would haunt used book stores to find treasures that people had cast aside. When Father John found a good book he absolutely glowed. His observation of what interests others is something to be admired which was evident when he gave me a DVD of the Philadelphia Flyers against the Russian hockey team. He paid great attention to what would please someone other than himself. Many noted that they felt an absence this past weekend without Father John being at the church. It hit me on Saturday when he was not sitting in the vestry waiting to greet people after the Mass. I will miss his love for our parish and his goodness in our rectory. It will take some time to adjust to him not getting up around 4:00 AM and I cannot get used to not finding him in the kitchen making French press coffee and pouring over the newspapers. Father John is a character and I mean that in the best sense of the word. His eccentricities are charming and while he may have diminished somewhat physically, I see that spiritually and intellectually, he is as powerful as ever. There will never be another like him and I know that I will not live with someone like him again. I truly believe that Father John will immerse himself even more deeply in prayer, in his books and listening to classical music. Please pray for him to have health and to continue to touch the hearts of those whom he encounters. He is not in a nursing home, but he will now live in our diocesan retirement home. 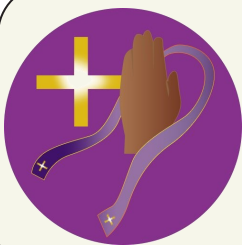

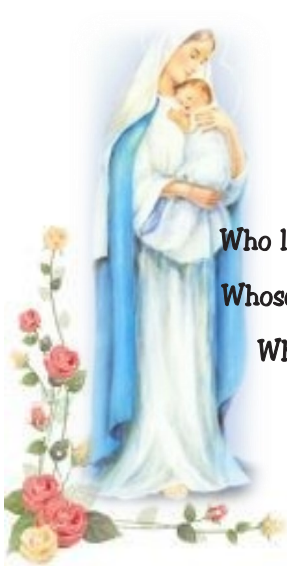
