A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Pope Pius XII wrote in *Haurietis Aquas*, “Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, of its very nature, is a worship of the love with which God, through Jesus, loved us, and at the same time, an exercise of our own love by which we are related to God and to other men. Or to express it in another way, devotion of this kind is directed towards the love of God for us in order to adore it, give thanks for it, and live so as to imitate it; it has this in view, as the end to be attained, that we bring that love by which we are bound to God to the rest of men to perfect fulfillment by carrying out daily more eagerly the new commandment which the divine Master gave to His Apostles as a sacred legacy when He said: ‘A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another as I have loved you.’” The month of June brings days of attention to the Sacred Heart of our dear Savior. We speak of heartache, of broken hearts and of big hearts. These are symbolic of something we believe is true about a condition or about someone. The heart symbolizes the very core of who someone is and thus, the Sacred Heart reveals to us that Jesus is love. Mother Teresa would say, “True love hurts. It always has to hurt. It must be painful to love someone, painful to leave them; you might have to die for them. When people marry they have to give up everything to love each other. The mother who gives birth to her child suffers much. It is the same for us in the religious life. To belong fully to God we have to give up everything. Only then can we truly love. The word ‘love’ is so misunderstood and so misused.” To be Christian, a Catholic, a disciple of the Lord takes a lot of love. Jesus has nothing to prove to us...it is we who have everything to prove to Him. O Sacred Heart of Jesus, make our hearts like unto Thine!”

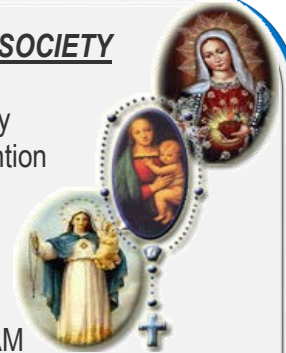

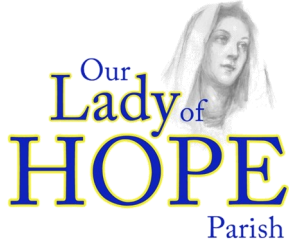

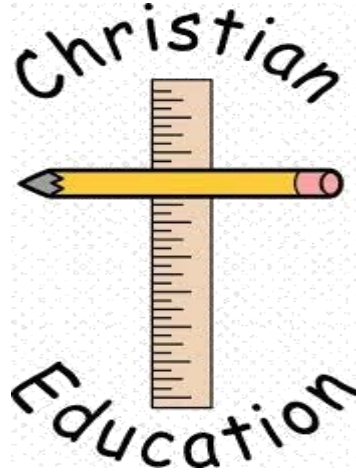
