A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

This past weekend was a beautiful time to celebrate the Real Presence of Our Lord. The feast of Corpus Christi is central to our faith and the Bishops of the United States are calling for a three year concentration on raising awareness and love for the Body and Blood of Jesus. Our diocese kicked off this three year celebration with Bishop Sullivan, priests, deacons, religious and the faithful of our diocese processing with the Most Blessed Sacrament on the Boardwalk in Atlantic City. Father March, Father Myers, Seminarian Jacob and I along with parishioners representing Our Lady of Hope participated in a candlelight procession. It was very beautiful and witness to love amidst one of the most secular and at times, decadent of places. On Sunday, we had a procession on our own parish grounds with the Blessed Sacrament. While I was a bit disappointed with the number, I am grateful to those who came and walked with our Lord in our midst. We processed from the church at the end of the Noon Mass to the first altar which was in front of the rectory. I gave a little homily, blessed the faithful and then Father March carried the Holy Sacrament to the second altar which was in front of Our Lady's grotto. Father gave a homily followed by Father Myers carrying the Blessed Sacrament to the front of the statue of Jesus where he offered a homily. I then processed the Sacrament into the church for Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. I pray that the Lord was pleased with our expression of love for Him and that this beautiful tradition will be carried out every year with even more fanfare. Archbishop Fulton Sheen once said, "The greatest love story of all time is contained in a tiny white host." Our parish continues to be blessed because we have a fervent love for the Real Presence and we love the Mother who bore Him.

PRAY-REFLECT-ACT

Religious Freedom Week takes place June 22-29. Beginning with the feast day of Sts. Thomas More and John Fisher, includes the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, and ends with the feast of Sts. Peter and Paul. The theme for this year is **Life and Dignity for All**. This year, as we approach the Supreme Court's decision in *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) is especially mindful of the debates around our country about abortion. The Catholic Church plays a crucial role in bearing witness to the gospel of life and serving all who will be affected by these discussions and their outcomes.

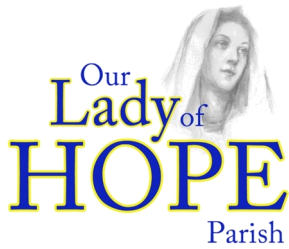

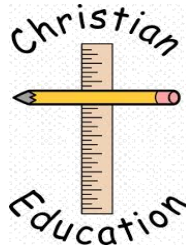
