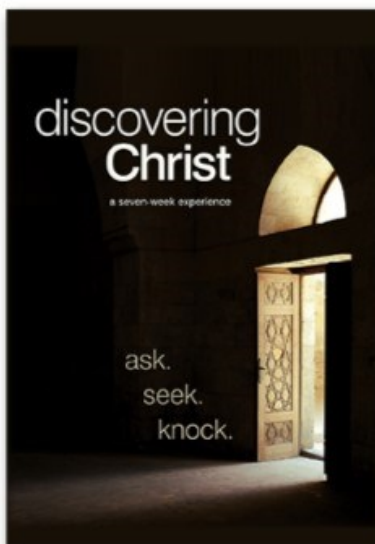
A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

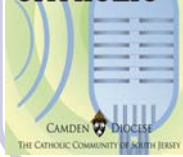

Religious Freedom Week takes place June 22-29. Beginning with the feast day of Sts. Thomas More and John Fisher, includes the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, and ends with the feast of Sts. 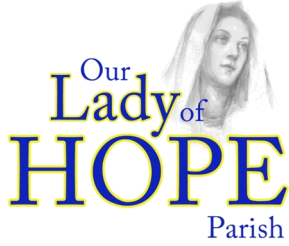

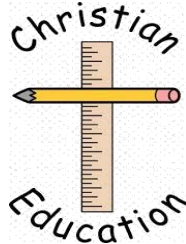

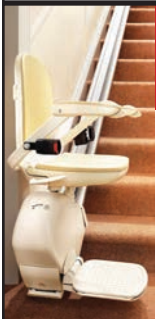
