## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

Not long ago, I was writing a personal check and of course, it required that one affix the date. I was inspired to put 12 July AD 2022. Not the AD which stands for Anno Domini (“in the year of the Lord”). BC or Before Christ is usually placed after the year as in 2022 BC. The use of BC and AD was first carried out in 525 by Dionysius Exiguus who was a monk. As the Julian and Gregorian calendars spread, BC and AD began to be used. One still sees the initials AD used on cornerstones and other significant markers. In our age where anything religious is taboo, Before Christ has now become BCE (“before the common era”) and CE (“common era”). Now, I get that non-Christians might not want to use BC and AD, but when I see BCE or CE in religious books or letters from the Church, the hair on my arms stands on edge. In the 1980’s (good for music, but not much else) the BCE and CE became even more common. As we see the eradication of our history through the dismantling of historical statues, so we can see a pushing of the Lord out of our common calendar use. For non-Christians, I get it. But for we who claim to be followers of the Lord Jesus, the King of kings and Lord of lords, I will never bow to this politically correct abbreviations. BC and AD all the way for me! I hate to say it, but the Gregorian calendar which so much of the world uses, including the United States of America, is a Christian based calendar. If I did not want to use the Christian initials, I would simply leave them out. The Christmas Tree is called by some a Holiday Tree and Easter Break is now a spring break. Hold on to everything Catholic Christian with all your might. Let us not lose our heritage to a spirit of this heathen age. Jerry Bower wrote in an article, *The Year of our Lord 2022 – Whether You Like It or Not*, “the main point is that Jesus is Lord. He is king. His reign continues. And pitiable attempts to distract us from that that, such as the academic fashion which tried to replace A.D., Anno Domini (Year of Our Lord) with C.E. (common era) only go to show how afraid the ruling classes are of Jesus. No one fears Thor any longer. If we did, we'd try to replace Thursday (Thor's Day) with some insipid euphemism. Thor was defeated by Christ. His name lacks power so no one even bothered to erase it. But anyone who insists that C.E. must replace A.D. fails to diminish Jesus' rule - we all know who it was who appeared sometime around Year One and had such a great impact that afterwards the whole world is in some sense in a common era. The attempt to blot that out simply shows their fear. Cancel cultures of all forms are fear cultures.” Words matter. It is great to be alive in the year AD 2022!
