A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Not too long ago, someone sent me a picture of a Catholic church in the Philippines. The church was flooded with water about two feet high. The photograph was showing a Mass which was crowded with the faithful. People...standing for Holy Mass in two feet of water! Should one wonder why I love the Filipino people! That love for the Holy Mass! Love for the Holy Eucharist! Love for "Mama Mary!" This is the spirit that should be in all of our hearts. Covid did so much damage, not as much physically, but spiritually. People have been lulled into the deception that it really is not necessary to go to Holy Mass every weekend. It is so easy to skip Sunday worship. What if Jesus had decided to skip the Friday on which He was crucified? What if He did not rise from the dead on a Sunday? How grateful we must be to Him that He did not say, "This is my day...I have more important things to do than to save my flock from sin and death?" Holy Mass is the closest we get to Heaven on earth. I recently attended a Fortieth Anniversary of ordination to the Holy Priesthood of Father Robert Pasley at Mater Ecclesiae parish. It was so beautiful: pageantry, incense, chant and total focus on God. No talking in church...heavenly! Many things have changed in the Mass in most Catholic churches. The modern Mass, known as the Novus Ordo (New Order) Mass, must be celebrated reverently so as to help to focus on Christ. Devout Church music, rather than show tunes, focus on the Lord rather than each other can immerse us in the mystery of God and touch Heaven for a brief time. I have a clock that chimes in my office. Very often I think of Saint Teresa of Avila who would exclaim when a clock chimed, "Ah, one more hour closer to Heaven!" Each Mass, Sunday after Sunday, even daily, is preparing us for the Heavenly Banquet. Come to Mass to worship Him, to experience His love. We prepare by realizing we not only want Him...we need Him! Each genuflection, our prayers, our silence and our dress all say, "Amen" (I believe). St. Leonard of Port Maurice said of the Holy Mass, "O you deluded people, what are you doing? Why do you not hasten to the churches to hear as many Masses as you can? Why do you not imitate the angels, who, when a Holy Mass is celebrated, come down in myriads from Paradise and take their stations about our altars in adoration to intercede for us?" Be faithful to Mass as there is no vacation from God. Think of those waterlogged people at Mass in the Philippines. They are far from delusion. They get it.

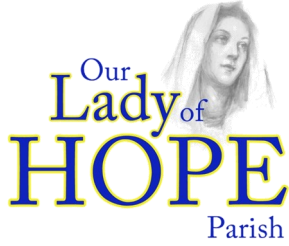

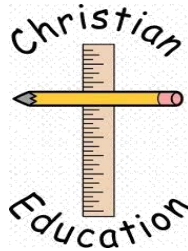

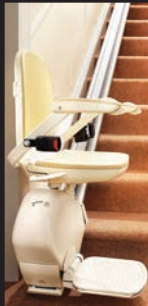
