## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

In the summer we often see a focus on water. Many during this month will go to the beach as August and September are the months that we see the warmest water temperature. It is never warm enough for me. Florida or Hawaii are more my temperature! We become thirstier in the summer, we may enjoy the pool or the ocean and we need the life-giving rains that keep everything so green. There is also a gift in the Church that helps to quench our spiritual thirst: Holy Water. The catechism tells us that “Sacramentals do not confer the grace of the Holy Spirit in the way that the sacraments do, but by the Church's prayer, they prepare us to receive grace and dispose us to cooperate with it. ‘For well-disposed members of the faithful, the liturgy of the sacraments and sacramentals sanctifies almost every event of their lives with the divine grace which flows from the Paschal mystery of the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Christ. From this source all sacraments and sacramentals draw their power. There is scarcely any proper use of material things which cannot be thus directed toward the sanctification of men and the praise of God.’” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1670). Holy water is a sacramental when we use it to bless objects or to bless ourselves. Things that are blessed are set aside for spiritual uses and not for any other activity. Blessed objects should be foreign to all superstition. They are to be used for the glory of God and to keep us close to Our Lord and His Holy Mother Mary. We should always bless ourselves upon entering the church or a chapel in order to remind us of our baptismal life and to cleanse us from the wickedness of unholy places. We have a metal container with a spout in the vestibule of the church. Bring your bottles to replenish your supply of holy water and sprinkle your homes and other places liberally. When you are tempted or afraid, do not reject this powerful sacramental. The great mystic Teresa Newman could detect when water was blessed or not. St. Teresa of Avila said she would die for one drop of holy water since what gave it its affectivity was the precious blood of Jesus. She believed this because of the ancient prayer that you say when blessing yourself with holy water. “By this holy water and by thy Precious Blood wash away all my sins, O Lord.” We can also use blessed salt along with Holy Water as a sacramental. Both purify and ward off evil. We cannot live without water and salt; using these sacramentals are tools that are a strengthening and protection. The exorcism and blessing of salt help us to see what comes about from Blessed Salt:

*O salt, creature of God, I exorcise you by the living (+) God, by the true (+) God, by the holy (+) God, by the God who ordered you to be poured into the water by Elisha the prophet, so that its life-giving powers might be restored. I exorcise you so that you may become a means of salvation for believers, that you may bring health of soul and body to all who make use of you, and that you may put to flight and drive away from the places where you are sprinkled; every apparition, villainy, turn of devilish deceit, and every unclean spirit; adjured by him who will come to judge the living and the dead and the world by fire.*

*Let us pray. Almighty and everlasting God, we humbly implore you, in your immeasurable kindness and love, to bless (+) this salt which you created and gave to the use of mankind, so that it may become a source of health for the minds and bodies of all who make use of it. May it rid whatever it touches or sprinkles of all uncleanness, and protect it from every assault of evil spirits. Through Christ our Lord.*
