A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Praised be the Lord Jesus Christ, Whose Real Presence in the center of our faith life at Our Lady of Hope Parish!

I ask that you refer to the copy in this bulletin of the decree that was promulgated by the Most Reverend Dennis J. Sullivan, Bishop of Camden, on August 8, 2022 “Regarding Parish Mass Schedules in the Diocese of Camden.” This is something that will affect every parish in the diocese and we will be looking on how to implement, out of obedience, the norms that the Bishop has decreed. The decree must take effect by July 1, 2023, so our discussion and planning will begin as soon as possible. The change that is indicated in the decree for our parish is that we would suspend one Mass on Sundays. At the very next meetings, I will discuss with the Parish Council and Finance Council how we would proceed. I will want input from the parishioners since it affects the faithful. We are blessed that we would still have a Saturday night Mass and four Sunday Masses. My immediate option is that rather than move the Mass schedule all around to be less one Mass, it would make sense to simply stop one Mass without any other change. That being said, I want to hear from the faithful. I am grateful to those who record the weekly numbers at each Mass. I will print that in the bulletin for your consideration. Also, for some time, I have been thinking about changing the daily Mass schedule to have 7:00 AM and 9:00 AM. It has never made much sense to me to have 8:00 and then while those attendees are leaving we go straight into a 9:00 AM Mass. 7:00 AM would allow those who work to go to daily Mass at Our Lady of Hope. All will be discussed and it must be decided in September since this would affect scheduling Mass intentions. All Mass intentions already scheduled will be fulfilled. You will be kept informed as this unfolds. Thank the Lord, we are a big parish. This is another sad reflection of our times with the priest shortage and lessen of people seeing the need for God and attending Holy Mass, the Sacrifice of Our Lord on the altar. Pray for more holy, zealous priests! Pray that we will again pack our churches! Remember the words of Saint John Vianney, “Put all the good works in the world against one Holy Mass; they will be as a grain of sand beside a mountain.”

DECREE REGARDING PARISH MASS SCHEDULES
IN THE DIOCESE OF CAMDEN

In order to better address the declining number of priests in the presbyterate of the Diocese of Camden, along with the decline in Mass attendance, and having taken counsel with both the Presbyteral Council and the Vicars Forane, in exercising vigilance over the celebration of the sacraments, in accord with canon 392 §2 of the Code of Canon Law, in order that the pastoral effort regarding the celebration of Mass may be more effective for the building up of the ecclesiastical community and so as to not overburden the priests of the diocese, allowing them to more adequately fulfill their ministry (cf. *Eucharisticum mysterium*, 25), I hereby decree the following in regards to Mass schedules in the Diocese of Camden:

1. A parish may have one Saturday evening Mass.
2. A parish may have two Sunday Masses if there is only one full-time priest assigned to the parish.
3. A parish may have one additional Mass on Sunday per full-time or part-time priest assigned to the parish as long as those Masses have an attendance of at least 60% of the capacity of the church building. A change in the Mass schedule will need to be made when staffing changes at the parish.
4. Parishes that serve the Latino community should incorporate the Mass celebrated in the Spanish language into the parish Mass schedule in accord with the guidelines above.
5. Parishes in the shore region of the diocese will need to plan, on an annual basis, the number of Masses they require and are able to cover. By May 1st of each year, pastors of shore parishes are to file their summer Mass schedule and coverage plan with the Office of the Chancellor.
6. In parishes with only one priest; the parish weekday Mass schedules may reflect the pastor's day off by having no Mass scheduled on that day. In addition, when the pastor is on vacation, the weekday Masses may be suspended. Eucharistic services are NOT TO BE CONDUCTED on these occasions; the faithful are to be provided with nearby parish Mass schedules so that they may participate in Mass.

This decree takes effect on July 1, 2023.

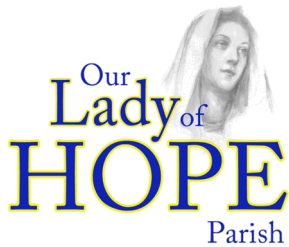

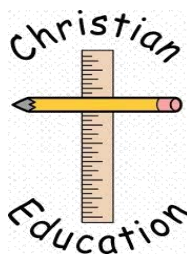

Not only did they learn about Jesus and his teachings but they also learned about service of self. After a week of learn and studying they ended the week with an act of service. The children made 444 peanut butter and jelly sandwiches, 272 utensil packets and 50 place-mats for the Cathedral Kitchen. They were excited and overjoyed to be able to help someone in need. We are so very proud of all the children.
