A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

There are seminal events which change one's life and so many around us. This weekend reminds us of September 11, 2001, when we witnessed events in New York City that would change the way the government monitors its people, security at airports amongst other places and the grief that so many still feel over the loss of loved ones and colleagues who perished on that day. If we are of age, most of us will remember where we were that morning. One of our seminarians, Edward Shea's Funeral Mass was taking place that day in Willow Grove, PA. I had the news on and as I was donning a pair of cufflinks, the first plane hit. I thought it was a mistake. I saw the second one live. After the Funeral, I was with a group of priests gathered around a small television in the rectory kitchen and the horror continued as we saw the towers collapse. I have visited the site of the towers to pray at the monument to the men and women lost. The museum is beyond poignant as people pass in hushed silence from display to display. One gets feelings like this when at places where terror has taken place. I was so moved to visit the monument to the people lost in the Oklahoma City blast, to see the motel in Memphis where Martin Luther King was shot or to stand in Pearl Harbor praying as one stares at the USS Arizona. While we cannot sustain the outrage and pain that horrific events cause, we also should not simply move on and forget. A while back, I visited Russia and noted that World War II was still so present to the people in Saint Petersburg. They were not so quick to forget as so often, we Americans can. We must keep our memory and never forget that people's whose lives were taken are remembered and that we pray for them. This goes for our own beloved dead. Less and less people go to Funeral Masses, Viewings or visit graves. The Church teaches about those who die: "The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned. The Church formulated her doctrine of faith on Purgatory especially at the Councils of Florence and Trent. The tradition of the Church, by reference to certain texts of Scripture, speaks of a cleansing fire. As for certain lesser faults, we must believe that, before the Final Judgment, there is a purifying fire. He who is truth says that whoever utters blasphemy against the Holy Spirit will be pardoned neither in this age nor in the age to come. From this sentence we understand that certain offenses can be forgiven in this age, but certain others in the age to come." (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1031) and "To understand this doctrine and practice of the Church, it is necessary to understand that sin has a double consequence. Grave sin deprives us of communion with God and therefore makes us incapable of eternal life, the privation of which is called the 'eternal punishment' of sin. On the other hand every sin, even venial, entails an unhealthy attachment to creatures, which must be purified either here on earth, or after death in the state called Purgatory. This purification frees one from what is called the 'temporal punishment' of sin. These two punishments must not be conceived of as a kind of vengeance inflicted by God from without, but as following from the very nature of sin. A conversion which proceeds from a fervent charity can attain the complete purification of the sinner in such a way that no punishment would remain." (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1472). Having Masses offered for our dead and praying for them is a blessing for those to whom we say goodbye and we grow in faith, preparing ever well for when the time when the Lord calls us. We must avoid this amnesia that leads us to forget those who lost their lives through natural causes or through violent means. Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord! Let Perpetual Light shine upon them.

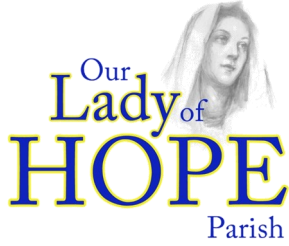

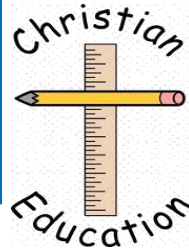

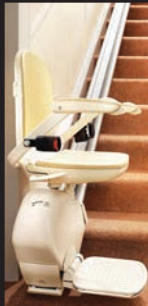
