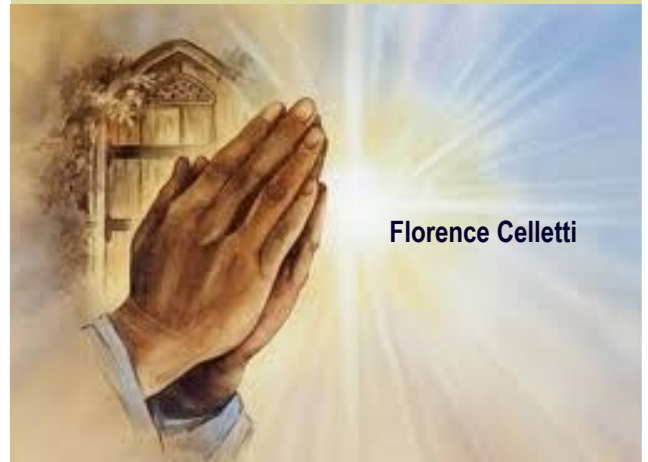

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

This past weekend, at every Mass, we watched a short video and heard an invitation from Vinnie Mancuso to join members of our parish in participating in Christ Life. This is an opportunity to be a better Catholic by being inspired to grow in holiness through a deepening of one's relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. The time of the Discovering Christ component of Christ Life will take place every Friday evening, from October 7th through November 18th. As noted, we will begin with a meal, have time for prayer and then meet with the group that one would be with for the seven weeks. Please pray over participating with your fellow parishioners. I know that people are busy, but I once heard, "If you are too busy for God, you are simply too busy for life." I am so grateful to our team who have been meeting regularly over these months and to all who have volunteered to carry out the necessary roles during the seven weeks of Christ Life. This is a quote from the Christ Life website about the first stage, *Discovering Christ*. "*Discovering Christ* is a seven-week experience where anyone and everyone, from the baptized in the pews to the unbaptized, is invited to hear the Good News and personally encounter Jesus Christ. *Discovering Christ* helps people enter into or renew a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, experience the love of God the Father, and be empowered by the Holy Spirit to live as God's children." Another event this month is the *Annual Blue Mass* where we honor our men and women who serve and who have served as police officers and first responders. Bishop Sullivan, the Bishop of Camden, will be the celebrant of this Mass which will take place in Saint Agnes Church. There is a lot of pageantry with men and women from armed services throughout our area. The band of pipers is literally chilling. I am so proud to be the son of a father who served as a police officer and detective. It is also an honor to have great love and respect for all police officers and those who respond to protect us from grave harm. An anonymous officer is quoted, "I don't have to draw a line in the sand. I already have one. It's thin. It's blue. It's mine and if you cross it, I will protect it." O men and women of courage! To all the officers in our parish, you have our gratitude, utmost respect and prayer for you and your families. May the Lord protect you from all harm as you keep the demonic away from the citizens of our society. A prayer was uttered by an officer: "And when we lay down our night sticks, enroll us in your heavenly force, where we will be as proud to guard the throne of God as we have been to guard the city of all the people." 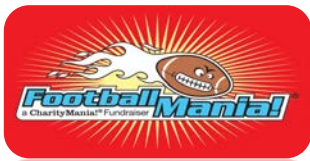

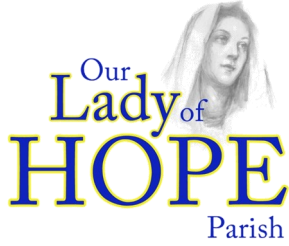

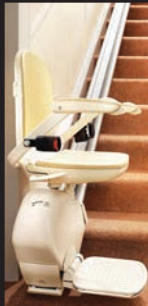
