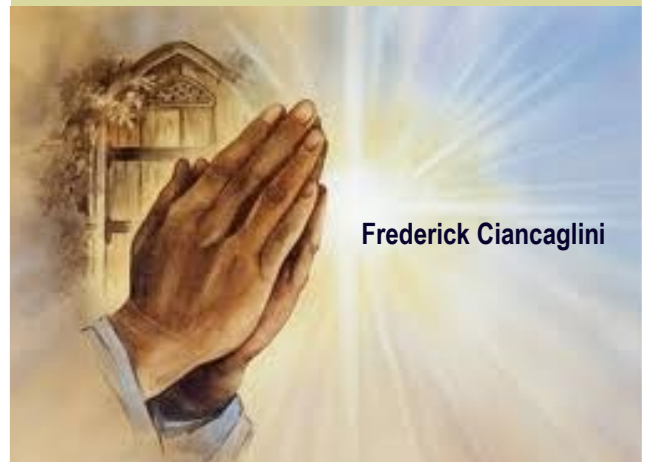

## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

We have now entered the month of October which is especially dedicated to the Holy Rosary. Every day, after the 9:00 AM Mass, those who desire pray the Holy Rosary as a group. This month, our parish will have two special opportunities to pray the Rosary together: Sunday, October 9<sup>th</sup> after the 12:00 PM Mass, we will process from the church to the grotto praying the Rosary, singing Marian hymns and having some prayer at Our Lady's Grotto on our property and the Knights of Columbus will host their annual Rosary Rally in Veteran's Park adjacent to the Gloucester Township Municipal Building. This will take place on Saturday, October 15<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 Noon. Both are beautiful ways to honor the Holy Mother of God. The month of October is also Respect Life month which is a month to pray for respect for all life at every age. We especially emphasize babies whose lives are destroyed in their own mother's wombs and who cannot defend themselves in any way. We also honor Saint Francis of Assisi on October 4<sup>th</sup> and we will bless pets at 4:00 PM, on Thursday, October 4<sup>th</sup> at the statue of Saint Francis outside the chapel. With the huge emphasis on ecology, Saint Francis is often invoked as an example of one who loved nature. Be assured, he was not a hippy who simply ran around talking to birds! Saint Francis had a powerful devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus; he did not simply speak to birds and fish; he preached to them! He would sweep the church sanctuary with a broom before he preached and he carried out such severe penances that he would go to the Lord at the young age of forty-six. His impact is felt today in a great way and it is sad when he is reduced to an environmentalist. He loved nature because nature reflects the Hand of God's love. Ecology was not a religion for him. The Lord Jesus Christ was the center of everything He thought and did in life. These are words attributed to Saint Francis of Assisi: "I believe that You, O Jesus, are in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You and desire You. Come into my heart. I embrace You. Oh, never leave me. May the burning and most sweet power of Your love, O Lord Jesus Christ, I beseech You, absorb my mind that I may die through love of Your love Who were graciously pleased to die through love of my love." Some have said that Francis of Assisi lived the Gospel more literal than anyone else who walked the earth. It is most unwise to reduce him merely to a birdbath ornament!

### October is the month Of Our Blessed Mother Traveling Statue of Mary

**Q:** Why does a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary go from home to home in some communities?

**A:** The origin of this custom is the so-called shelter seeking - that is the Holy Family on their way to Bethlehem, seeking a shelter where they could stay for the night, and where Mary could give birth to Jesus. Out of the recollection of this event grew the medieval Frauen Tragen (carrying of our Lady) in Germany, and later the so-called Posada (house, dwelling, inn) in Hispanic countries. The custom is a 'spiritual compensation' for the innkeeper's refusal to invite the Holy Family into his Inn.

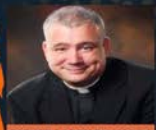

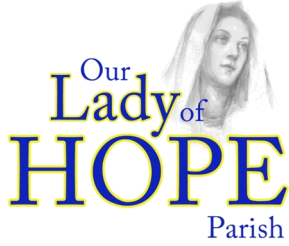

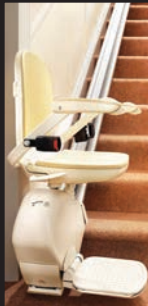
