## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

The Holy Spirit has truly been active in the life of our parish breathing His love in so many hearts. Our charismatic prayer group, Flames of Fire, carried out a beautiful retreat that lasted two days bringing people from as far away as New York. This was an opportunity to give loving praise to the Lord, adoration of His Real Presence, the opportunity for confession and sharing faith with one another. Bishop Sullivan came onto our campus to honor our men and women who keep us safe at the 21<sup>st</sup> Blue Mass. Men and women from all over the area represented their fellow officers and who could not be moved at the powerful playing of bagpipes. As each officer's name was announced, a somber bell was rung. I can still recall the year my own father died and the emotion of hearing his name read along with the ringing of the bell is seared into my memory and heart. A few days later, Bishop Sullivan returned to Our Lady of Hope Parish to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation in two services. He offered strong homilies that called all of us to live our Catholic faith with gusto and to remain fearless. He spoke of how so many people are "vacant" because they do not have the Lord in their lives. This description is so apt. I think of how many can be as though the living dead. I recently read an article on being alive in Christ. It said: "In fact, being alive in Christ means the opposite. A fully alive life requires a fully-experienced life. Without joy and sorrow, peace and turmoil, happiness and despair, you cannot fully appreciate anyone's experience. For a life to be fully lived it must be experienced in every extreme. The extent to which we are capable of experiencing great disappointment and pain is also the extent to which we have the capacity to experience the greatest joy. God is at work in the mundane, and the everyday messiness of our lives. Being alive in Christ does not mean we will be in a constant state of smiles and joy. Being alive in Christ means our foundation is so strong that even when the storms come, we can live through them. Take a moment right now to remember that Christ invites you to live a life in Him. Know that, in Christ, your feet are firmly planted on an unshakable foundation: Christ's unconditional love for you. Jesus promised us, "... *Look, I am making everything new...*" (Revelation 21:5)." I truly pity those who do not have the Lord in their life. Our Catholic faith, when truly lived, is so transformative. If we live "through Him, with Him and in Him," then we do not have to be afraid of where we are going. Call upon the Holy Spirit throughout the day and then the Lord will do wonderful things in our lives. The Holy Spirit is empowering our parish with His love!

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful and kindle in them the fire of Your love.

Send forth Your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

O God, Who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations.

Through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.

### October is the month Of Our Blessed Mother Traveling Statue of Mary

**Q:** Why does a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary go from home to home in some communities?

**A:** The origin of this custom is the so-called shelter seeking - that is the Holy Family on their way to Bethlehem, seeking a shelter where they could stay for the night, and where Mary could give birth to Jesus. Out of the recollection of this event grew the medieval Frauen Tragen (carrying of our Lady) in Germany, and later the so-called Posada (house, dwelling, inn) in Hispanic countries. The custom is a 'spiritual compensation' for the innkeeper's refusal to invite the Holy Family into his Inn.

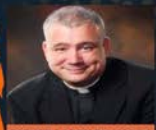

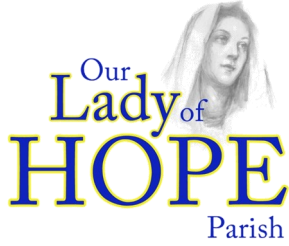
