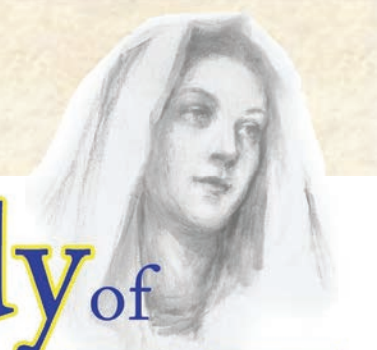

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

As you know, the Bishop of Camden has decreed that parishes lessen their Mass schedule. In obedience, we took specific steps to ask the faithful about their thoughts to advise me in changes to the Mass schedule. Firstly, we announced that people could write to me or call me to offer their opinion on the upcoming changes. Thank you to those who handwrote, emailed, and left messages concerning your opinion. Father March collected information from parishioners and recorded that so that all opinions could be shared with our Parish Council who discussed the matter very thoroughly. They gave me their thought on the schedule and after prayer, the following will be our Mass schedule beginning in July of 2023: the 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM daily Mass schedule will remain in place; the weekend schedule will be 4:30 PM on Saturday and 7:30 AM, 9:30 AM, 11:30 AM and 6:00 PM. I pray that this is acceptable to all. As for the intentions at Mass: 4:30, 7:30 and 6:00 PM will remain; the intentions for 9:00 AM and 10:30 AM will be merged into the 9:30 AM Mass (only the two intentions will be offered) and the 12:00 Noon will be said at 11:30 AM. Again, this does not take place until July as mandated by the bishop. Very importantly, this Tuesday and Wednesday (October 18th and 19th), the priests of the parish will be on their annual convocation and therefore, cannot offer Holy Mass on those two days. The decree of Bishop Sullivan reiterated the Church's teaching that "Communion Services" are not to be offered in place of Mass. The Church only offers this option for Sunday Masses when Mass cannot be offered. This is not the case in our diocese.

I have been asked why did the bishop mandate this? We are in a serious priest shortage and without a doubt, even our parish, one of the largest in the diocese, will be down a priest or two in the near future. We do not have a lot of men who are willing to give their lives in service of the Lord. We must always remember: no priest, no Eucharist, no Church. This is why we pray for vocations before every Sunday Mass begins. We are blessed that our church is large enough to easily accommodate the new schedule and I am so grateful for your anticipated cooperation. As for not having a Communion Service, the purpose of Holy Mass is primarily the worship and adoration of the Father, through the Son in the unity of the Holy Spirit. It is not to merely receive Holy Communion. We are in a time where there is emphasis on the Real Presence. This means that if we are in serious sin (including missing Mass for no reason), we should refrain from Holy Communion until we confess to a priest. Receiving the Lord in sin is a sacrilege. This is the Church's teaching. Let us all make every effort out of love for the Lord to receive Him with great care and devotion. If one receives in the hand, snatching the Sacred Host or popping the Host into one's mouth is offensive. Also, it is forbidden for someone to break off part of their received Host and giving it to a child or someone else in the pew. This is sacrilegious. We should consume the Host immediately upon reception on one's tongue or if desired, in the hand (not one handing it unless carrying a cane or one can only use one arm). As your pastor, it is imperative that I protect the Most Blessed Sacrament in every way possible. We are a parish where many, many people pray before Our Lord's Real Presence; this is bearing so much fruit, praise God!

October is the month Of Our Blessed Mother Traveling Statue of Mary

Q: Why does a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary go from home to home in some communities?
A: The origin of this custom is the so-called shelter seeking - that is the Holy Family on their way to Bethlehem, seeking a shelter where they could stay for the night, and where Mary could give birth to Jesus. Out of the recollection of this event grew the medieval *Frauen Tragen* (carrying of our Lady) in Germany, and later the so-called *Posada* (house, dwelling, inn) in Hispanic countries. The custom is a 'spiritual compensation' for the innkeeper's refusal to invite the Holy Family into his Inn.
Altar and Rosary provides a Traveling Mary Statue to parishioners and members of our society who wish to have it in their homes for special intentions, novenas and prayers to the Blessed Mother. 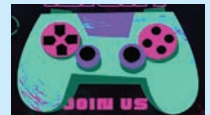

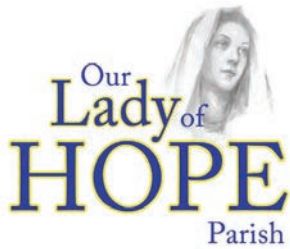

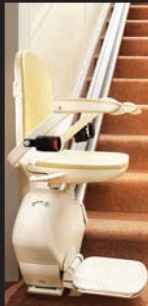
