## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

On October 1<sup>st</sup>, we had the bishop on our campus to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to our young people. It was a beautiful day in the spiritual life of our parish. While Confirmation was taking place, there were parishioners conducting a special task. The facilities on our campus: the church, the chapel, the parish offices and especially the Parish Hall, are used constantly and thus, have a lot of wear and tear. So many ministries and groups use our Hall and the various rooms and kitchen facilities. Our Business Manager, Tracy Pezzuto; our Maintenance, Norberto Cruz; Anna Scafidi and Anna O'Toole planned and helped to execute the day with excellent leadership of other parishioners and the faithful from various ministries. We literally needed a dumpster to rid the facility of collected "things" over quite some time. To all involved, including Father March, who was happy to know we were cleaning things up, I offer one great "Thank you!" We have redone the flooring in the meeting rooms and look forward to next year, redoing the great hall. Ownership of our parish is so important and thus, please remember that this is all yours. We priests come and go, but this is your spiritual home and like any home, it must be cared for. We are so blessed with a large church and other wonderful facilities with lots of land. Again, the faithful of Our Lady of Hope own it all and for it, must take responsibility. Practical suggestions are to please put the song books back in their pew rack; if you see trash on the floor, throw it out and sterilize your hands; keep the bathroom respectful, not throwing items on the ground, etc.; closing doors to keep in the heat or air conditioning, let alone, avoiding bugs and squirrels; coffee cups are left in the vestibules of our facilities and so often, I feel as though I should be called Father Jeeves, the butler!

### October is the month Of Our Blessed Mother Traveling Statue of Mary

**Q:** Why does a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary go from home to home in some communities?  
**A:** The origin of this custom is the so-called shelter seeking - that is the Holy Family on their way to Bethlehem, seeking a shelter where they could stay for the night, and where Mary could give birth to Jesus. Out of the recollection of this event grew the medieval *Frauen Tragen* (carrying of our Lady) in Germany, and later the so-called *Posada* (house, dwelling, inn) in Hispanic countries. The custom is a 'spiritual compensation' for the innkeeper's refusal to invite the Holy Family into his Inn.  
**Altar and Rosary provides a Traveling Mary Statue to parishioners and members of our society who wish to have it in their homes for special intentions, novenas and prayers to the Blessed Mother. 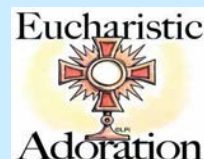

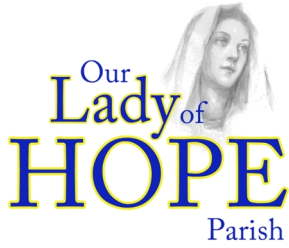

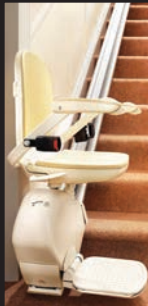
