## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

We will enter the month of the Holy Souls, as November is dedicated to the Souls. The Catechism of the Catholic Church, Article 12, 1020 says, "The Christian who unites his own death to that of Jesus views it as a step towards him and an entrance into everlasting life. When the Church for the last time speaks Christ's words of pardon and absolution over the dying Christian, seals him for the last time with a strengthening anointing, and gives him Christ in viaticum as nourishment for the journey, she speaks with gentle assurance:

Go forth, Christian soul, from this world  
in the name of God, the almighty Father,  
who created you,  
in the name of Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God,  
who suffered for you,  
in the name of the Holy Spirit,  
who was poured out upon you.  
Go forth, faithful Christian!  
May you live in peace this day,  
may your home be with God in Zion,  
with Mary, the virgin Mother of God,  
with Joseph, and all the angels and saints....  
May you return to [your Creator]  
who formed you from the dust of the earth.  
May holy Mary, the angels, and all the saints  
come to meet you as you go forth from this life....  
May you see your Redeemer face to face.

None of us can escape death. It is our passage to the life to come and despite our attempts to pretend it will not happen, all of us will end this life to enter our eternal life. The Church teaches us that there is purgatory, Heaven, and hell. Heaven is eternal bliss with God, participating in the Beatific Vision of God; purgatory is the necessary cleansing that must take place as nothing unholy can stand before God (we do not know how this takes place and we are no longer bound by time and space). It is hopeful, because we know that with the prayers of the faithful, we will eventually go to Heaven. Hell is the knowledge and existence that tells us that we will never see God nor enjoy His eternal blessing. Our rejection of Him as Savior, our living a sinful, unrepentant life and basically living this life as though He does not exist, finds us in this horrific, eternal state. God is both just and merciful and we make choices that affect eternal life. It is so important that one goes to confession regularly as we do not know when our life will end. When a loved one is extremely sick, they should call for the priest, receive absolution, be anointed and receive Holy Communion in a state of grace in preparation for our final journey. Masses offered for the dead are what aids a person to pass from their purgatorial state to be with our Loving Savior forever. On November 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Church celebrates All Souls Day. We will have Holy Mass at 8:00 AM; 9:00 AM and 7:00 PM in our Saint Agnes Church. One also receives an indulgence when visiting a cemetery and praying for the dead on All Souls Day.

### October is the month Of Our Blessed Mother Traveling Statue of Mary

**Q:** Why does a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary go from home to home in some communities?  
**A:** The origin of this custom is the so-called shelter seeking - that is the Holy Family on their way to Bethlehem, seeking a shelter where they could stay for the night, and where Mary could give birth to Jesus. Out of the recollection of this event grew the medieval *Frauen Tragen* (carrying of our Lady) in Germany, and later the so-called *Posada* (house, dwelling, inn) in Hispanic countries. The custom is a 'spiritual compensation' for the innkeeper's refusal to invite the Holy Family into his Inn.  
**Altar and Rosary provides a Traveling Mary Statue to parishioners and members of our society who wish to have it in their homes for special intentions, novenas and prayers to the Blessed Mother. 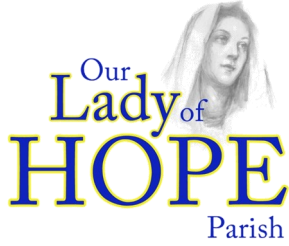

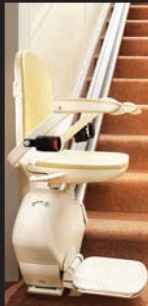
